Mandatory Training at the University Of Windsor For Animal Surgeons

Prior to undertaking any procedures involving drug-induced anaesthesia or survival surgery all persons must take the Surgery Workshop at the University of Windsor conducted by the ACC Veterinarian or provide proof of equivalent training to the satisfaction of the ACC Veterinarian.

The following guide matches SOPs with the topics students will be required to learn.

Training for Lab Animal Surgery - Wet Lab

1. Handling, health and monitoring
2. Injections
 - a. Technique
 - b. Dosing
 - c. Drugs
3. Anesthesia
 - a. Administration and “top-up”
 - b. Monitoring animal / depth
4. Surgery
 - a. Aseptic technique
 - b. Relevant surgical techniques (taught by appropriate faculty member or other qualified personnel)
5. Recovery / postoperative care / health monitoring

Animals to be used in this training will be part of an approved research protocol.

Undergraduate students: Students will only require supervision during surgical procedures until they have been deemed competent in surgical procedures.
