Transfer Credit: As part of the admissions process, submission of transcripts, detailed course outlines and/or other relevant documentation must be submitted to the [Registrar's Office](#) for transfer credit evaluation. A copy of the assessment would then need to be submitted to the Odette School of Business. Course exemptions will only be considered after transfer credit has been assessed.

Note: to be eligible to obtain the Post-Graduate Certificate in Accounting, students must obtain residency requirements (6 courses taken at UWindsor) AND must take ACCT 4590, ACCT 4600, ACCT 4610 at UWindsor.
