

## Minor in Entrepreneurship

### **Business Courses (6):**

**STEN-1000. Introduction to Business** (normally offered Fall, Winter, Intersession/Summer)

**STEN-2900. Fundamentals of Entrepreneurship** (normally offered Fall, Winter, Intersession/Summer)  
(Prerequisite: STEN-1000. Business students must also have completed MGMT-1000.)

**STEN-3910. New Venture Formation** (normally offered Fall and Winter)  
(Prerequisite: STEN-2900.)

**STEN-4930. Field Study in Strategic Management and Entrepreneurship** (normally offered only Winter)  
(Prerequisite: STEN-3910, fourth year standing or consent of the instructor.)

**STEN-4910. Special Topics in Strategic Management and Entrepreneurship – taken TWICE with different topics** (normally offered Fall and Winter)  
(Prerequisite: STEN-3910, fourth year standing or consent of the instructor.)

### **Please note the following:**

- Students must obtain a minimum grade of 60% in each course applied to the Minor.
- Students may not complete both the Minor in Entrepreneurship and the Minor in Business Administration. Business students are not eligible to complete this minor.
- Non-Business students are only permitted to take up to **9** Business courses.
- All pre-requisites are enforced as appropriate. Some STEN-4910 courses may require pre-requisites not listed above. Check UWinsite for full details.
