## Current Calendar Degree Requirements

Total courses: forty.
(a) Communication, Media and Film - fourteen courses, including CMAF-1010, FILM-1100, CMAF-2340, CMAF-2750, plus one of CMAF-2010, CMAF-2250, CMAF-3340 or CMAF-3750, plus nine additional CMAF or FILM courses, at least two of which must be at the 3000 level or above (excluding CMAF-3990) and at least one of which must be at the 4000 level (excluding CMAF-4990);
(b) Course requirements-Other subject: courses used to calculate the major average in the other subject area, as prescribed by that area of study;
(c) GART-1500, GART-1510;
(d) two courses from Arts;
(e) two courses from Languages or Science;
(f) two courses from any area of study, excluding Social Sciences;
(g) additional courses from any area of study, including CMAF and FILM to a total of forty courses.

Courses used to calculate the major average are: All courses taken in CMAF and FILM, as well as the combined major area(s) of study.

## Sample Sequencing

This sample can vary greatly depending on the second major and its requirements and scheduling.
Year 1 fall (5 courses): CMAF-1010 (also offered in winter); FILM-1100; 2 courses from second major; GART-1500

Year 1 winter ( 5 courses): Another 1000 or 2000-level CMAF/FILM course; 1 course from second major; GART-1510; 2 Arts, Language or Science, or other non-Social Science electives

Year 2 ( 10 courses): CMAF-2340; CMAF-2750; 2 additional 2000-level CMAF/FILM courses depending on interests; 4 courses from second major; 2 Arts, Language or Science, or other non-Social Science electives

Year 3 ( 10 courses): 1 of CMAF-2010, CMAF-2250, CMAF-3340 or CMAF-3750 (or any other CMAF-, if requirement already satisfied); 3 additional CMAF/FILM courses, at least 1 of which must be at the 3000-level; 4 courses from second major; 2 Arts, Language or Science, or other non-Social Science electives

Year 4 (10 courses): 1 CMAF/FILM course at 4000-level; 2 additional CMAF/FILM courses, at least 1 of which must be at the 3000-level; remaining courses from second major, and then courses from any area of study, including CMAF/FILM, to total 40 courses.
