

Communication, Media & Film Degree Requirements

UWinsite Student also helps you keep track of other important degree requirements, such as cumulative and major GPAs, senior-level requirements.

Honours 4-Year

Current Calendar Degree Requirements

Total courses: forty (Plus three work terms for students in the Co-op program).

(a) eighteen courses, including CMAF-1010, FILM-1100, CMAF-2340, CMAF-2750, plus one of CMAF-2010, CMAF-2250, CMAF-3340 or CMAF-3750, plus thirteen additional CMAF or FILM courses, at least two of which must be at the 3000 level or above (excluding CMAF-3990) and at least two of which must be at the 4000 level (excluding CMAF-4990);

(b) GART-1500, GART-1510;

(c) two courses from Arts;

(d) two courses from Languages or Science;

(e) two courses from any area of study, excluding Social Sciences;

(f) six courses from any area of study, including CMAF and FILM;

(g) eight courses from any area of study, excluding CMAF and FILM.

Courses used to calculate the major average are: All courses taken in CMAF and FILM.

Sample Sequencing

Year 1 fall (5 courses): CMAF-1010 (also offered in winter); FILM-1100; GART-1500; 2 non-CMAF/FILM electives to help satisfy Arts, Languages or Science, non-Social Science requirements

Year 1 winter (5 courses): Another 1000 or 2000-level CMAF/FILM course; GART-1510; 3 non-CMAF/FILM electives

Year 2 (10 courses): CMAF-2340; CMAF-2750; 5 additional 2000-level CMAF/FILM courses depending on interests; 3 non-CMAF/FILM electives

Year 3 (10 courses): 1 of CMAF-2010, CMAF-2250, CMAF-3340 or CMAF-3750 (or any other CMAF-, if requirement already satisfied); 4 additional CMAF/FILM courses, with at least 2 at 3000 level; 2 courses from any area of study, including CMAF/FILM; 3 non-CMAF/FILM electives

Year 4 (10 courses): 2 CMAF/FILM courses at 4000 level; 1 additional CMAF/FILM course; 4 courses from any area of study, including CMAF/FILM; 3 non-CMAF/FILM electives
