**Assistants cannot commence their GA/TA duties until email confirmation of the approval of their contract is received from Human Resources.**

GA employees are expected to make themselves available to report for all assigned duties, **both in-person/on-campus and remote/online duties**. Most classes across the University are expected to be held face-to-face on campus or have a face-to-face component. Refer to the University's current [health and safety regulations](#).

**Eligibility requirements:**

**Successful applicants must be available to attend at the specified time of the course/lab/exams and to report for all assigned duties, which may include both in-person/on-campus and remote/online duties.**

GA appointments will be offered to qualified applicants in accordance with the criteria specified in Article 12:03 of the CUPE4580 Collective Agreement.

To be eligible for a Graduate Assistantship you must be a **registered fulltime graduate student:**

- must be registered for the term of work at the time of hiring
- must maintain **fulltime** registration throughout the term and must be in good standing in the degree program

GA appointments cannot exceed **140 hours total for the Fall term period (Sept. 1<sup>st</sup> to Dec. 31<sup>st</sup>) or the Winter 2025 term period (Jan. 1<sup>st</sup> to Apr. 30<sup>th</sup>)**. Refer to Articles 12, 13, and 14 of the CUPE 4580 Collective Agreement for eligibility details.

**Required essential qualifications:** Successful applicants must meet all essential qualifications.

**EDUC 5201:** Preferred: Preference will be given to applicants that have studies related to educational philosophy; teaching experience (K-12, extracurricular or alternative learning settings)

**EDUC 5202:** Required: Teaching experience K-12 or experience with classroom management. Preferred: Interest in social justice education or background in Social Studies would be an asset.

**EDUC 5203:** Required: Must be available to attend lectures; Preferred: Preference given to applicants with background in educational/development psychology; Degree in Psychology would be an asset.

**EDUC 5204:** Required: Must have good communication skills; Must be able to navigate/utilize Brightspace for instructional and communicative purposes. Preferred: Preference will be given to applicants who have a background in special education.

**EDUC 5209:** Required: Background with assessment and evaluation

**EDUC 5210:** Preferred: Preference will be given to applicants with classroom management or classroom teaching experience

**EDUC 5211:** Required: Must have good communication and organizational skills; Knowledge and understanding of online teaching tools and platforms; Must be able to attend lectures. Preferred: Preference will be given to applicants with background in mental health and psychology.

**EDUC 5314:** Required: Excellent oral and written English proficiency; Attend lectures.

**EDUC 5315/EDUC 5366:** Required: Background in Mathematics Education; Attend classes; Assist group activities; Provide constructive comments on assignments

**EDUC 5316:** Required: Good communication; Excellent writer; Preferred: Preference will be given to applicants with formal background in music.

**EDUC 5317:** Required: Must have background in PJ teaching with classroom experience; good understanding of elementary science curriculum in Ontario; Good assessment and evaluation skill to provide meaningful feedback.

**EDUC 5318:** Preferred: Preferences for applicants who are graduates of our Pre-Service program (P/J) or students with teaching experience and familiarity with Ontario P/J curriculum. Must be available to attend lectures.

**EDUC 5332:** Required: Excellent English communication skills; Participatory digital communication; Experience with providing feedback; Experience with creating digital artifacts, including videos, blogs, podcasts; Experience with social media; Understanding of Universal Design for Learning (UDL) principles and differential learning; Preferred: Research interest in ICT.

**EDUC 5207/xxxx:** Required: Good communication skills with diverse student body; ability to monitor on-line discussions and to fulfill all duties on campus. Interest in teacher education and K-12 education; Liaison with Chinese RLP participants to prepare for arrival on campus; Preferred: Bilingual competence in English and Chinese will be an asset.

\* This may be one individual holding a GAship for 2 semesters (280hrs.), or two individuals holding a 1 semester GAship each (140hrs.)

\*\* These positions will be 2 individuals holding a GAship for 140 hours each.
