# Faculty of Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences Research/Creative Activity Excellence Award

Application Deadline: March 29, 2024

#### **Purpose:**

To honour a faculty member who makes outstanding contributions to research and/or creative activity that elevate the reputation of the Faculty of Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences in the local community, regionally, nationally, and internationally.

#### **Criteria:**

The committee will be examining the application packages for evidence of:

- local/regional/national/international research contributions (invited presentations/performances, and publications/creative works);
- local/regional/national/international recognition of research, scholarly, creative activity contributions (awards);
- research and/or creative activity that raises the profile and reputation of the Faculty and the university;
- research and/or creative activity that embraces the principles of equity, diversity, inclusion, and decolonization;
- initiation of or participation in local/regional/national/international research and/or creative activity partnerships, collaborations, and/or groups;
- research and/or creative activity that is novel and innovative and that has contributed significantly to the field of research/creative activity in the candidate's field(s) of expertise; and
- research and/or creative activity that provides opportunities for student training and mentorship.

## **Eligibility:**

Full-time faculty members and academic ancillary staff who have been employed by the Faculty of Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences for at least three (3) years

#### **Nomination Process:**

Nominations may be made by supervisors, Department Heads/Directors, or faculty colleagues.

## **Application Packages:**

Application packages will include:

- Nomination letter detailing how the candidate meets the criteria above
- 1 letter of support (nomination letter and letter of support must be from 2 different people internal or external to the university)
- Candidate's electronic curriculum vitae (ECV)

## **Review Process:**

Application packages will be circulated to the Award Committee electronically for individual review. The committee will then meet to discuss the applications and reach a decision ideally by consensus. The Award Committee will be struck through a call for nominations and chaired by the Dean of FAHSS. Attempts will be made to include three (3) FAHSS faculty members (ideally one from each area of FAHSS) and one (1) student representative on the committee.

# Award:

The Award will be given to one (1) individual each year. Successful applicants will receive a \$2,000 research grant and a framed certificate of achievement and will be highlighted at the annual FAHSS Celebration of Excellence/State of the Faculty Address.
