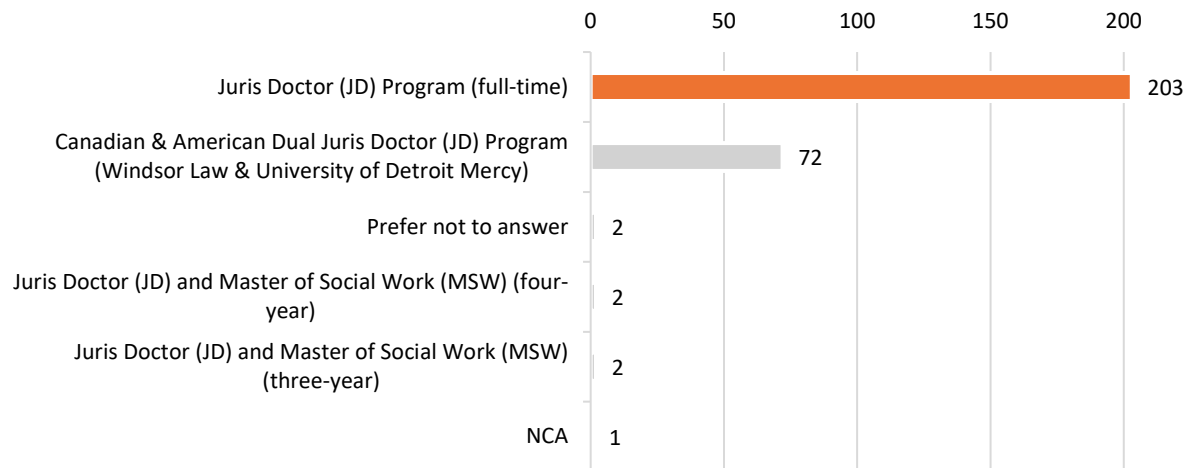

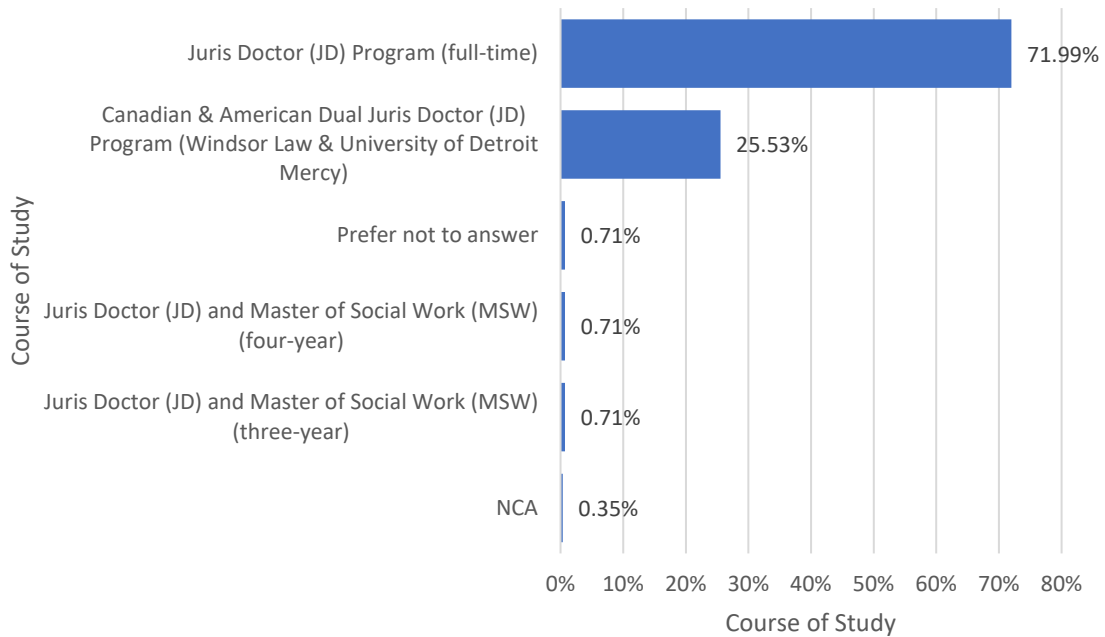

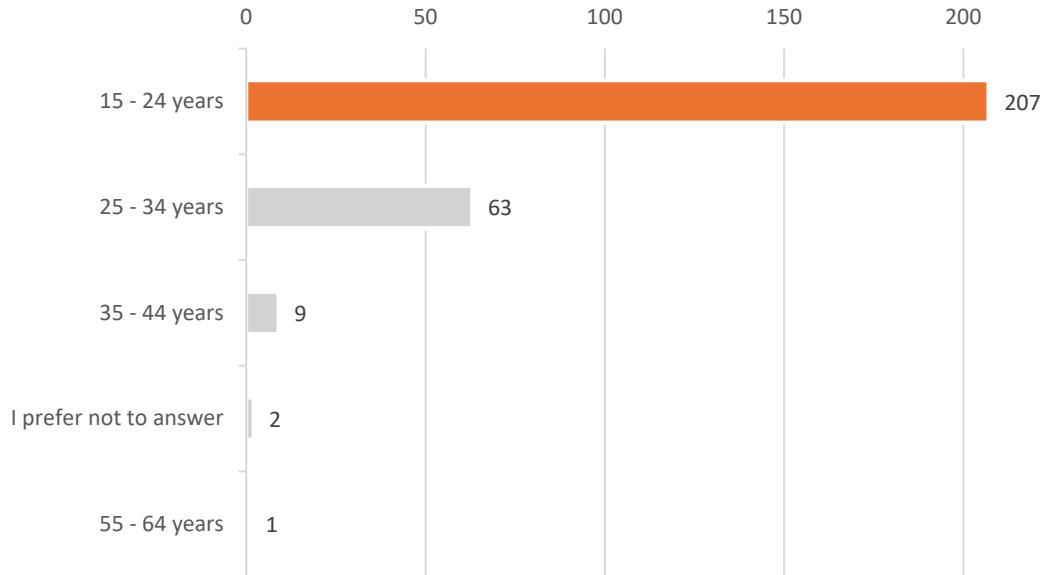

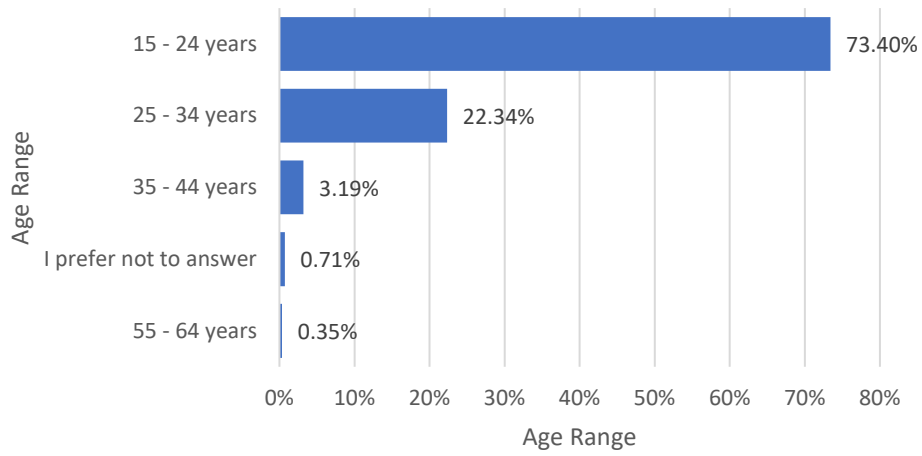

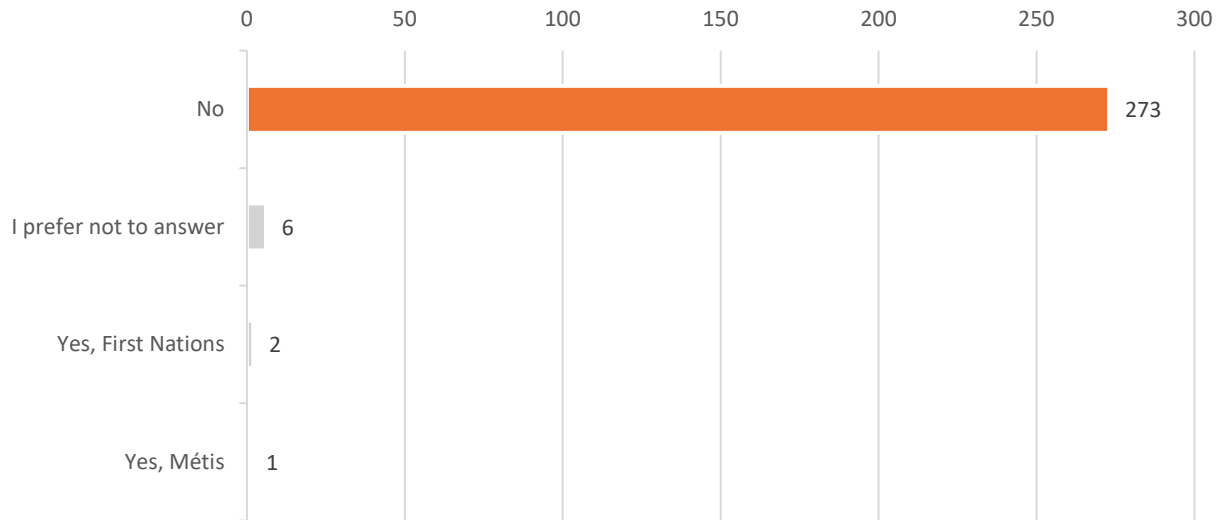

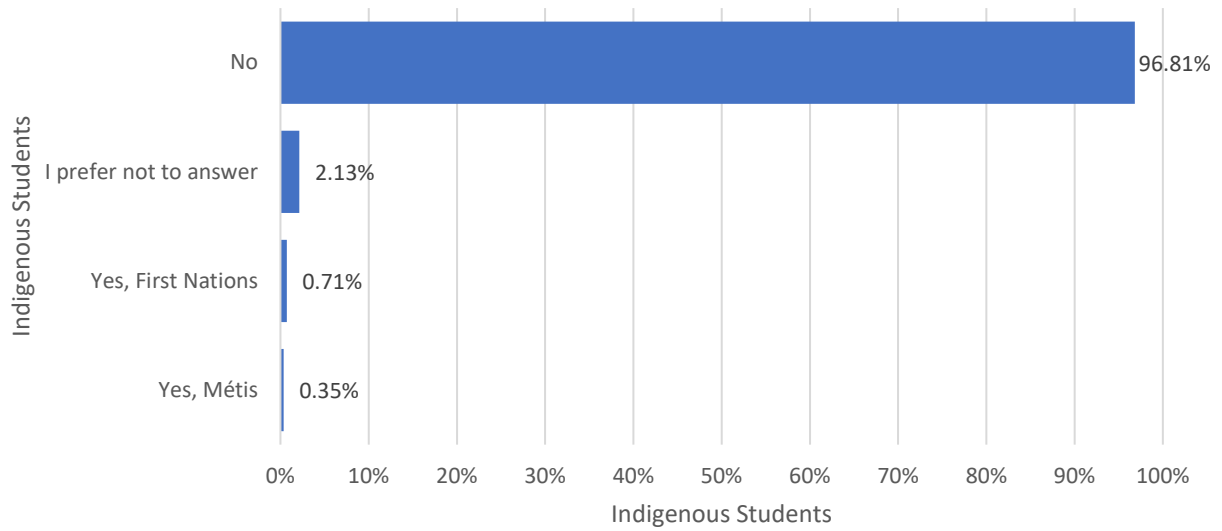

Percentage distribution of 'Indigenous Students'

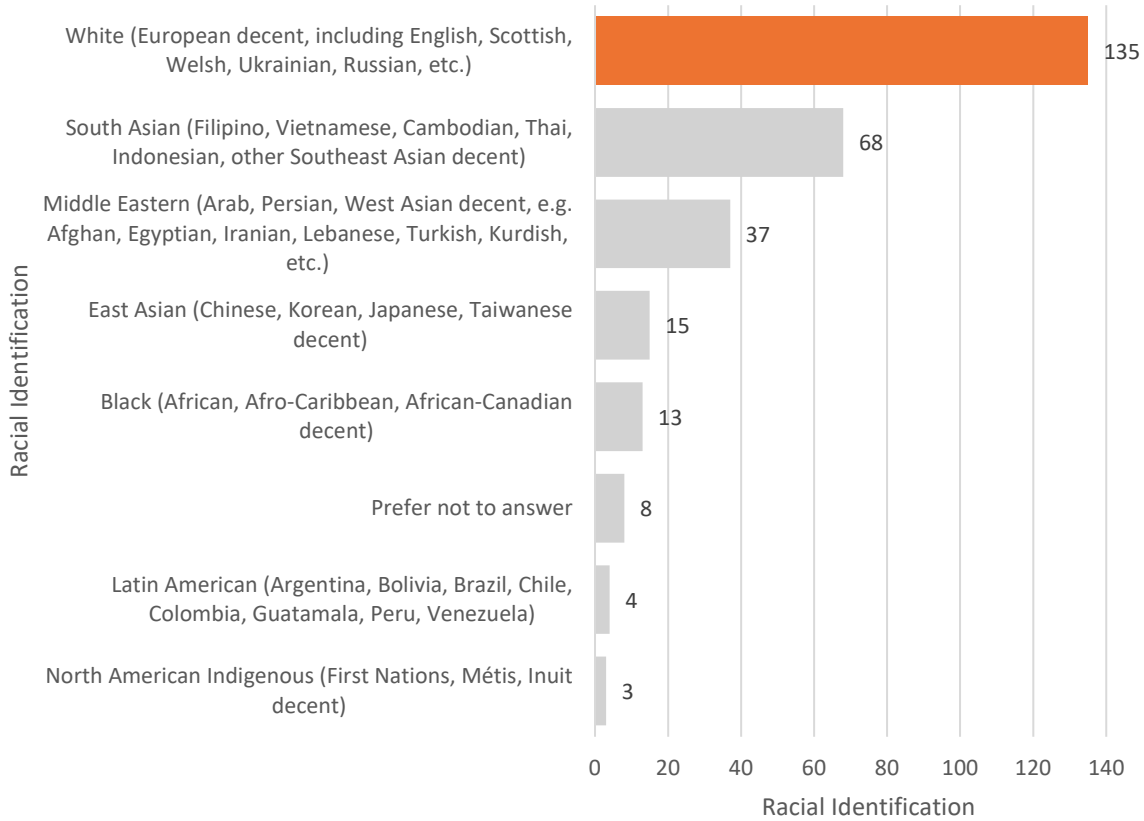

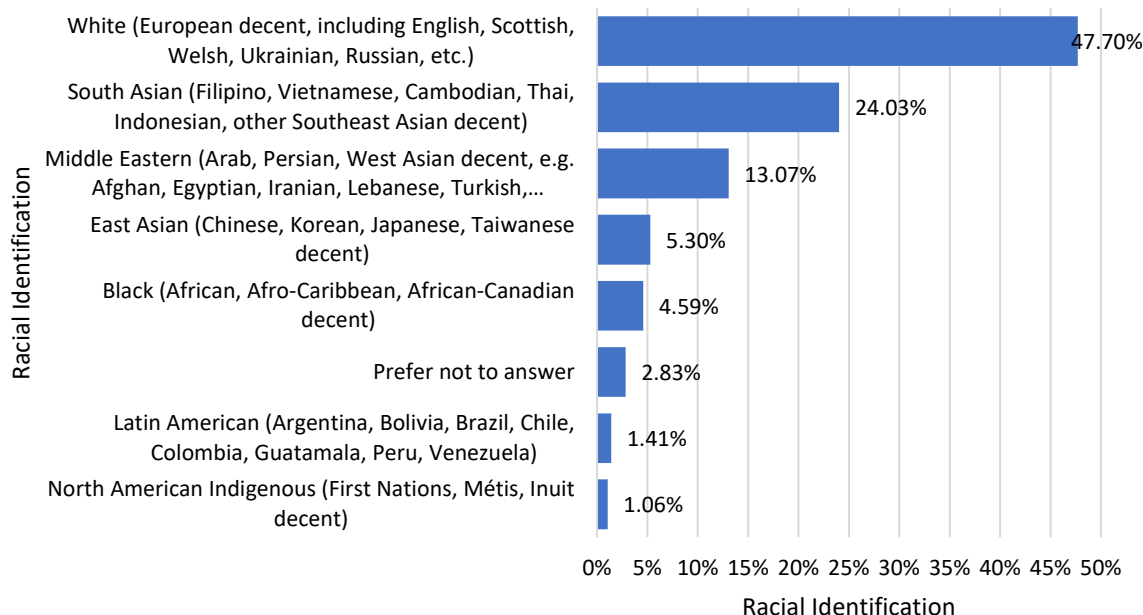

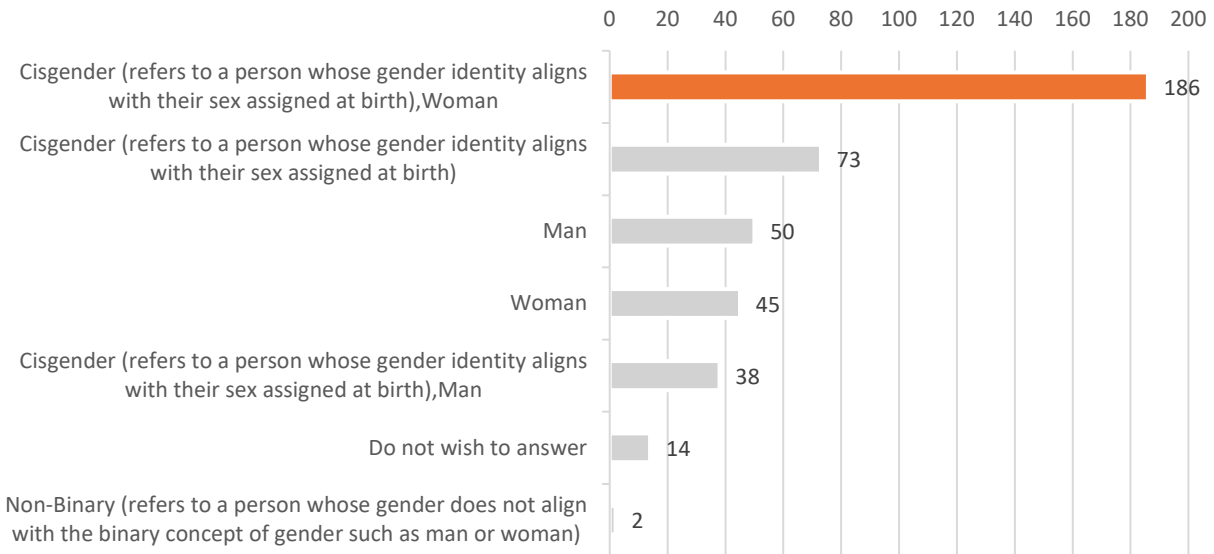

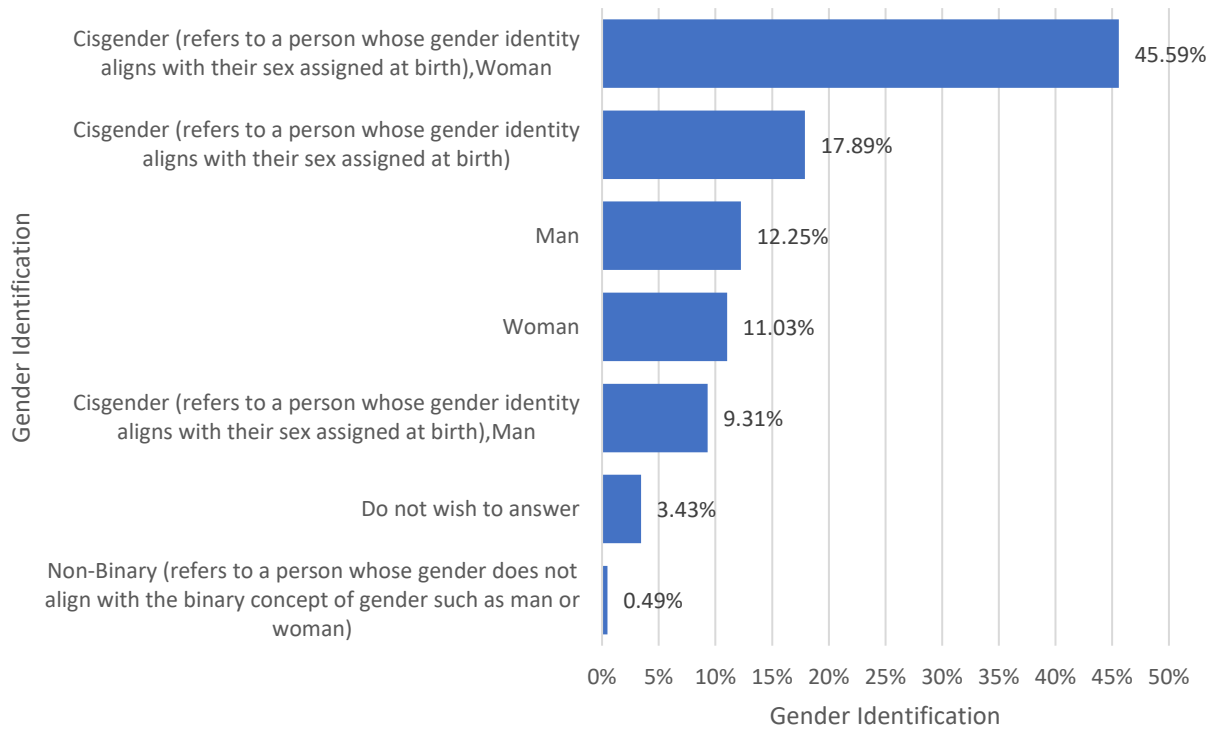

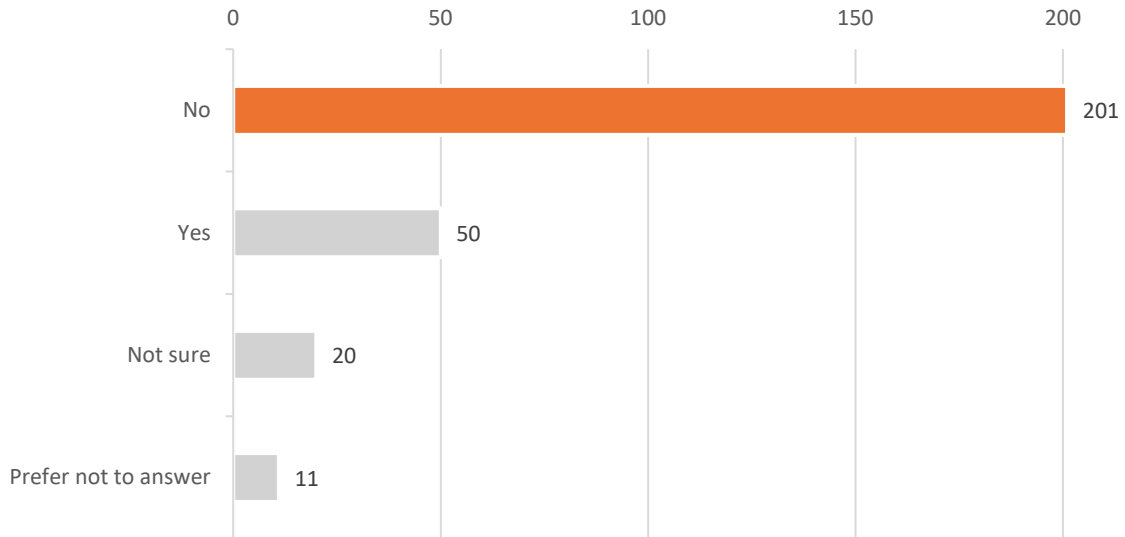

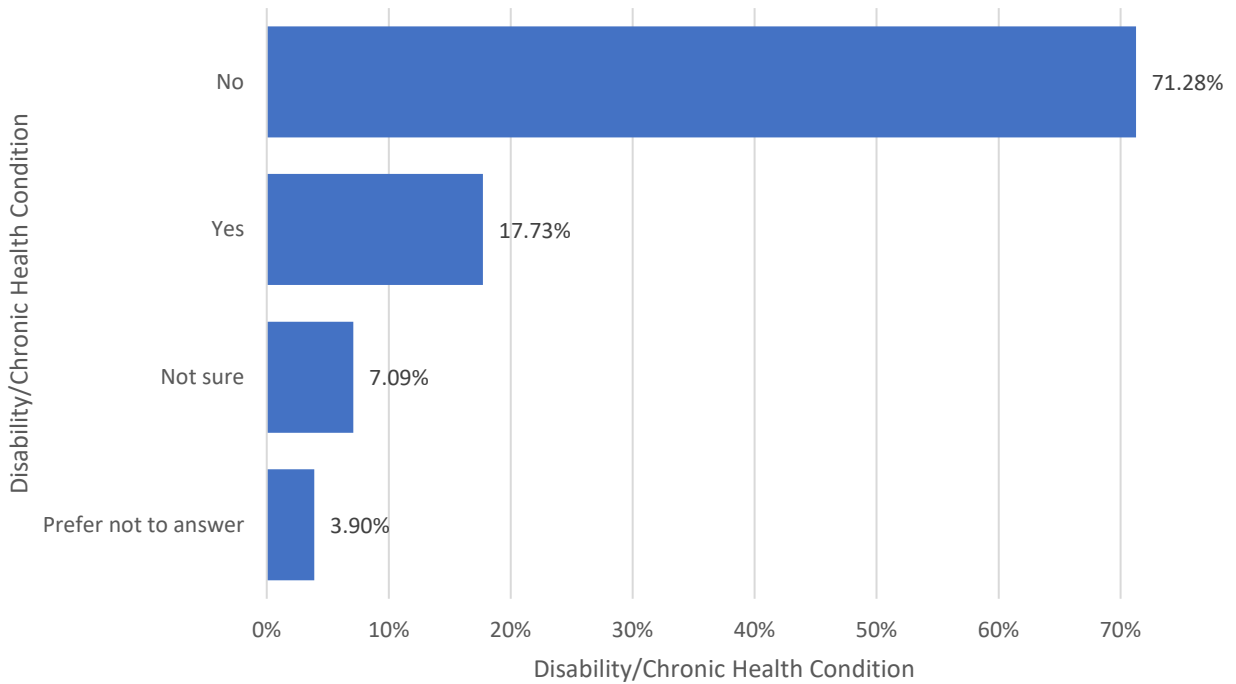

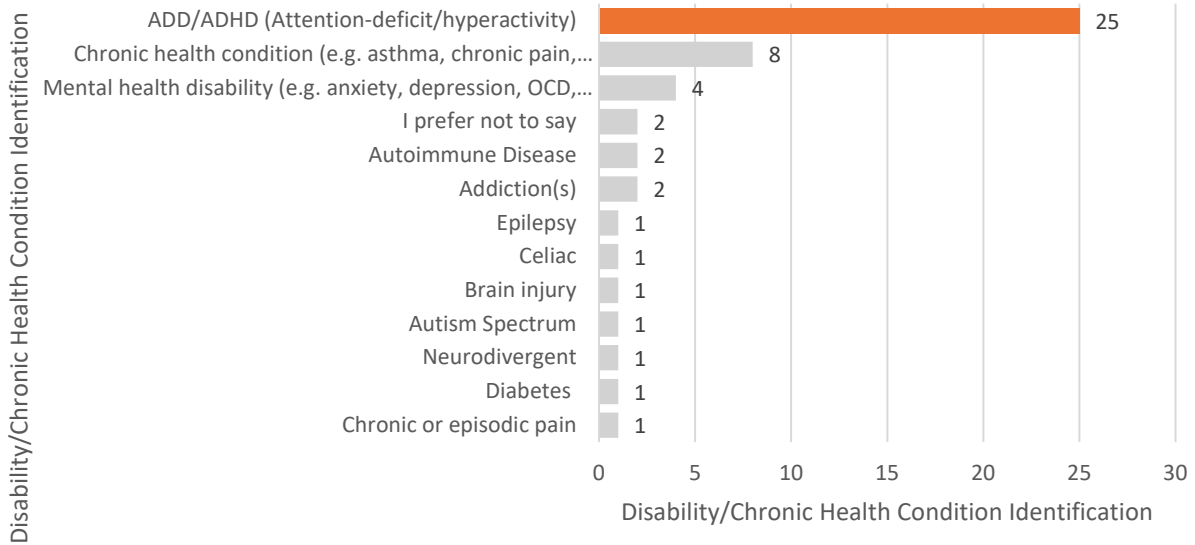

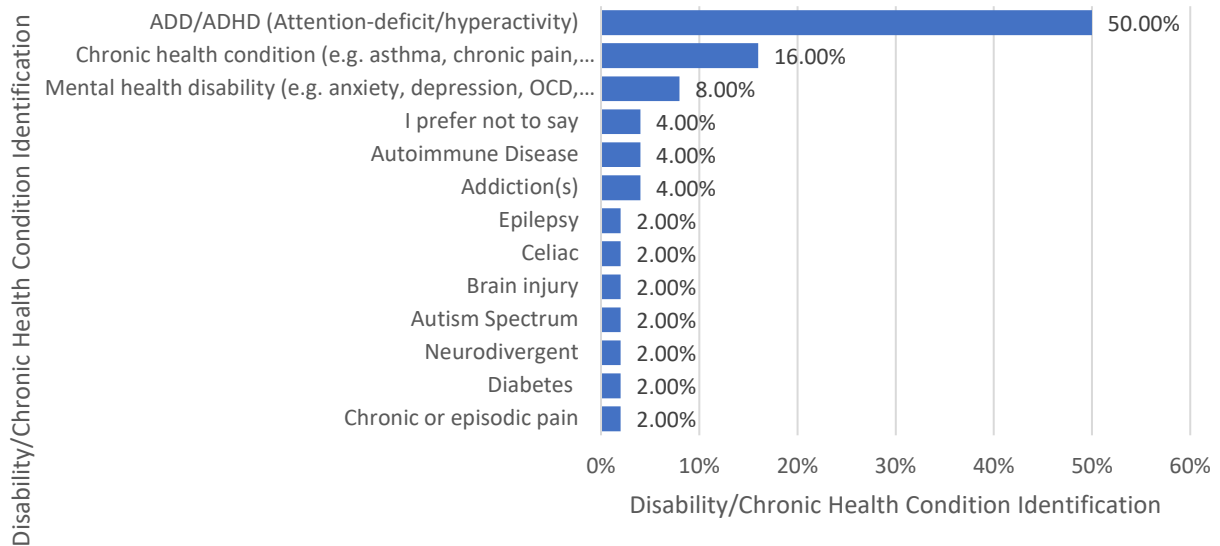

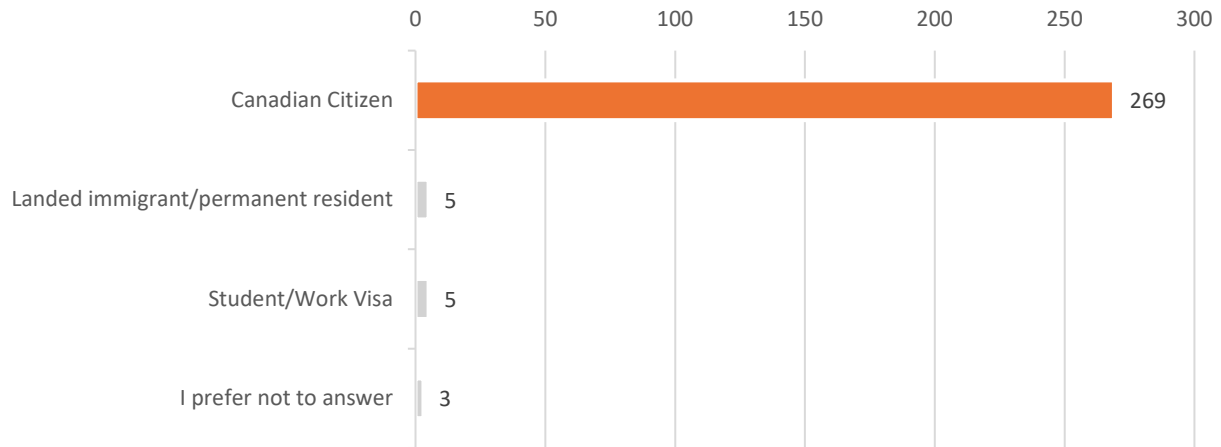

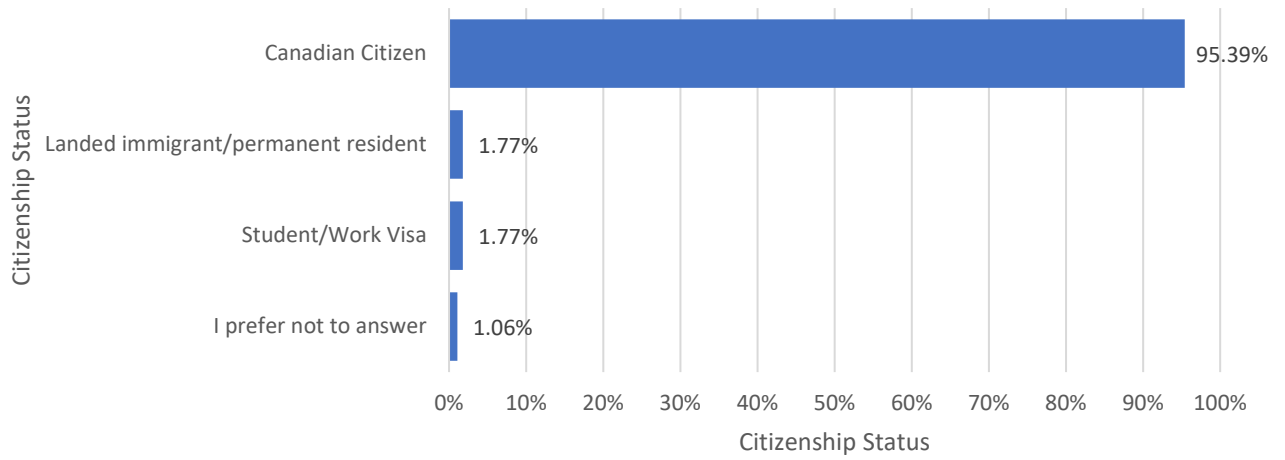

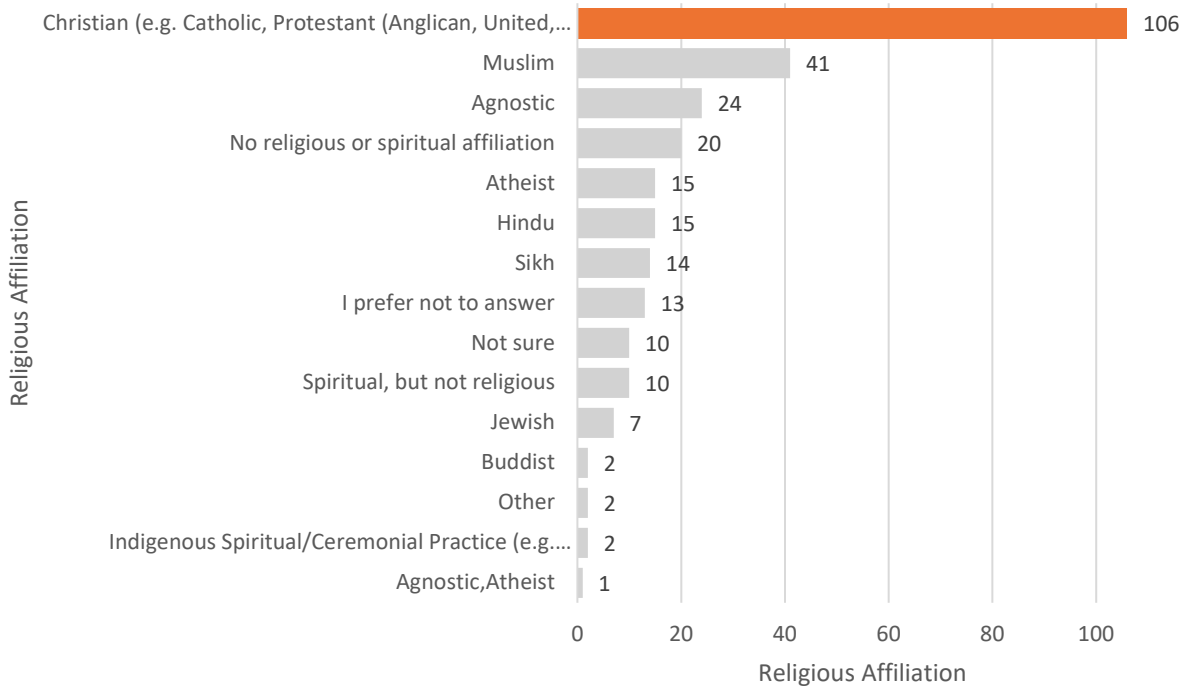

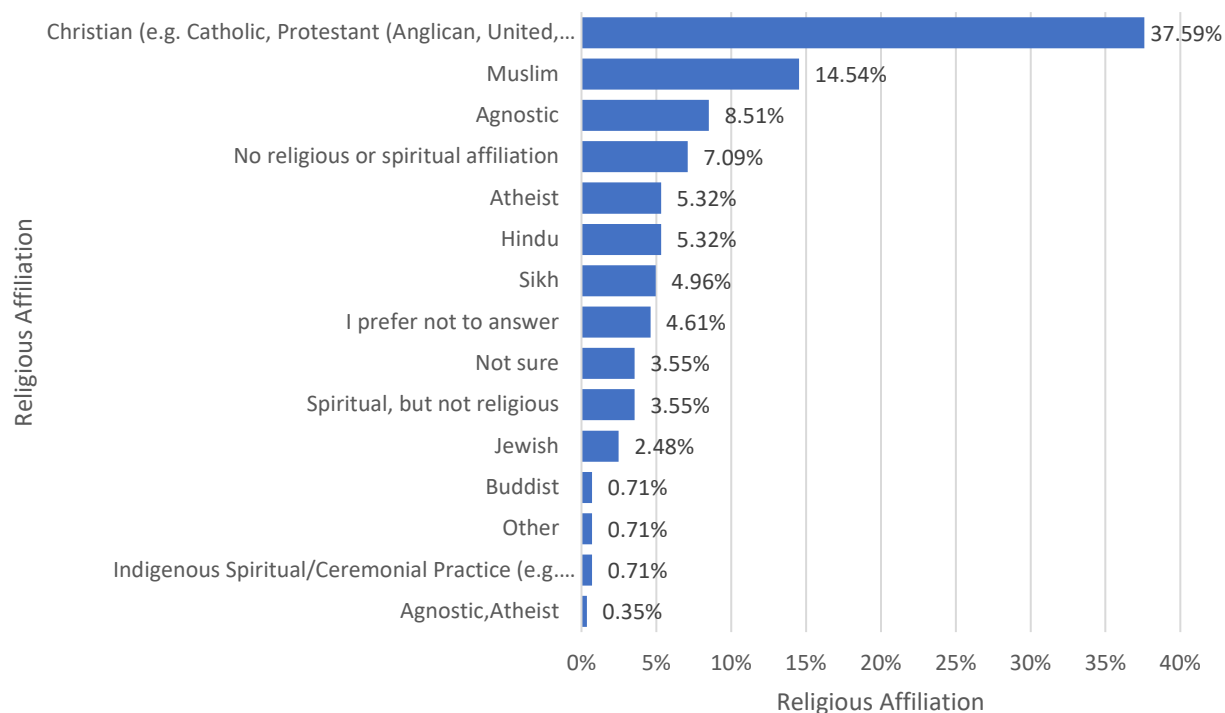

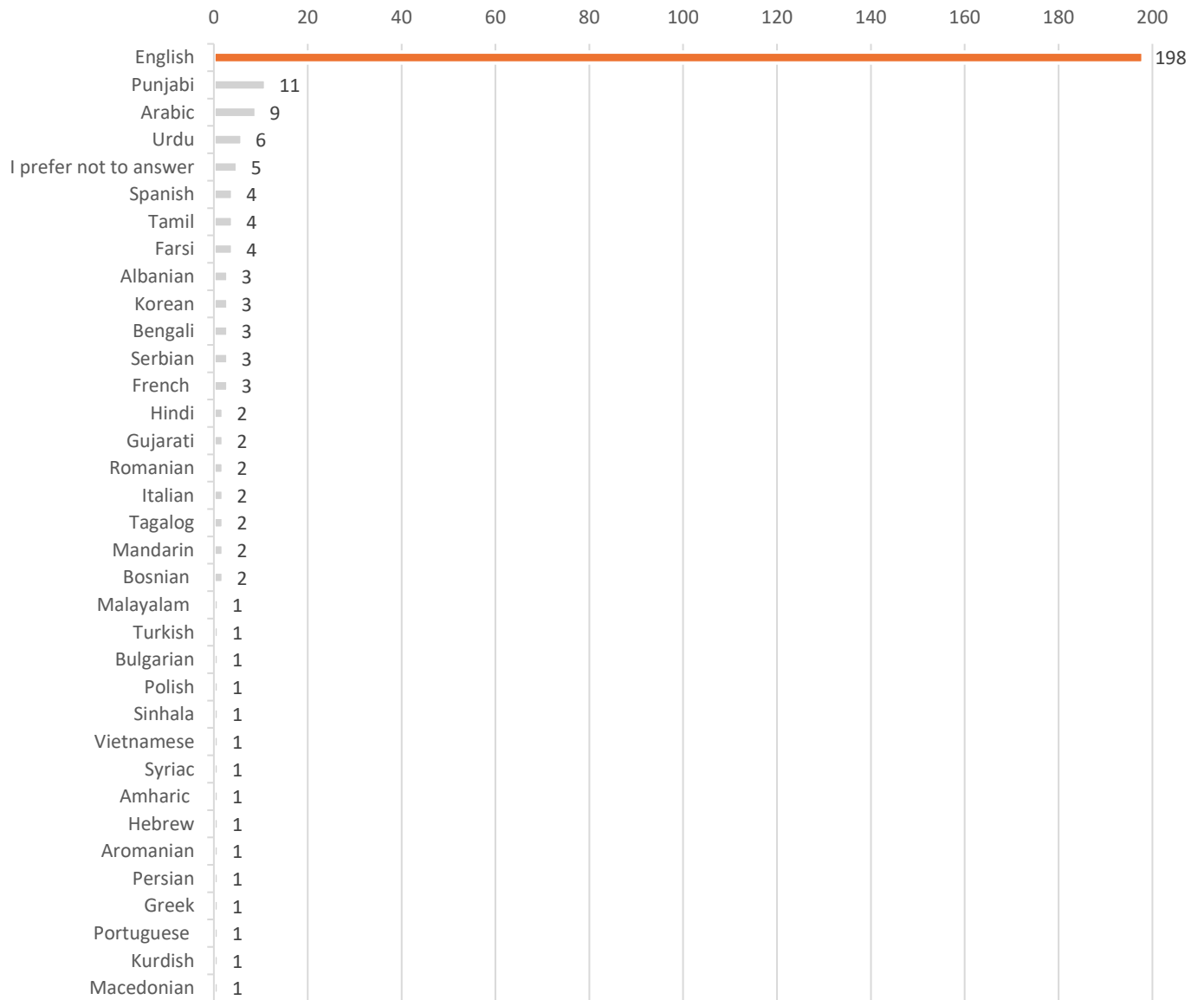

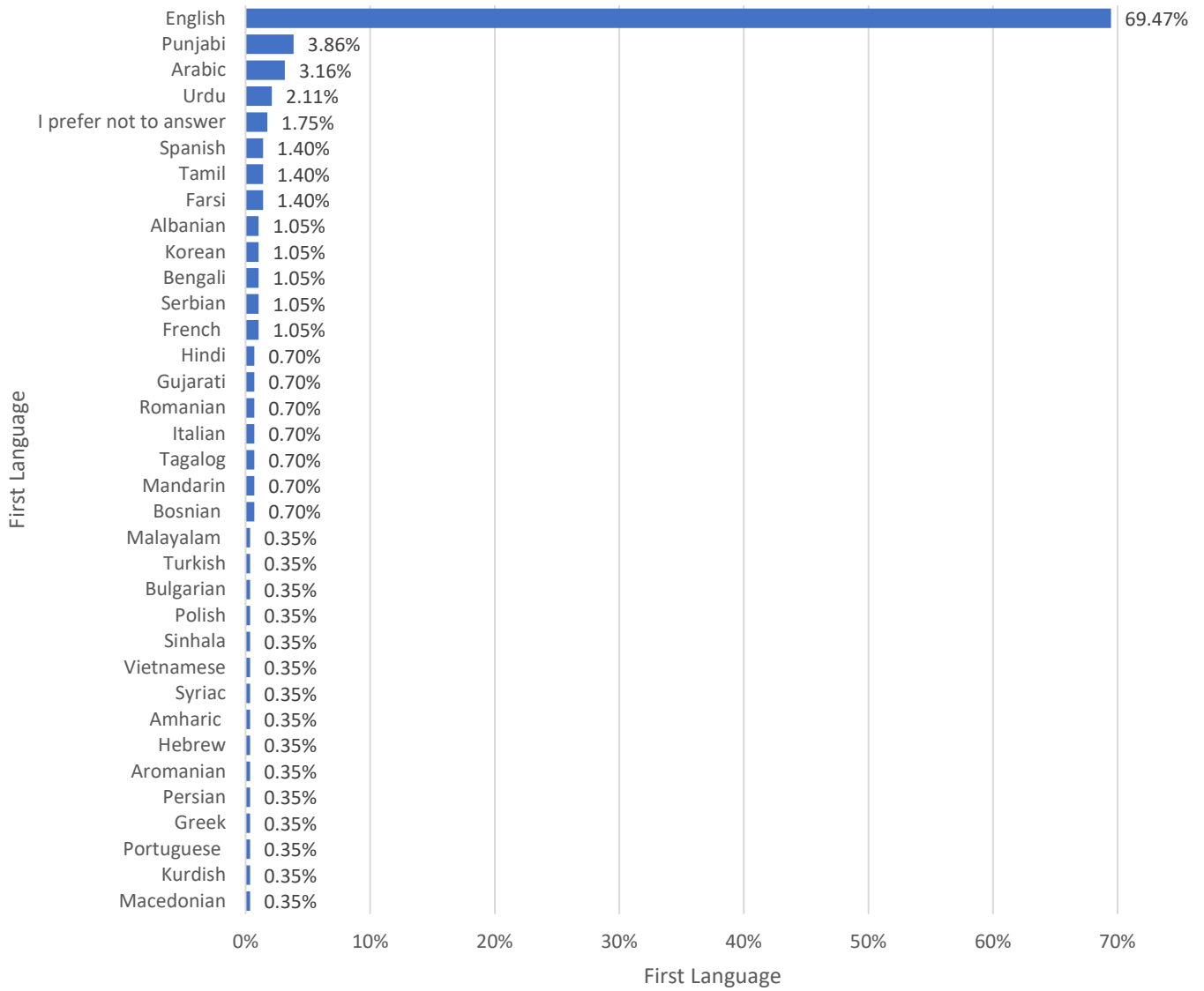

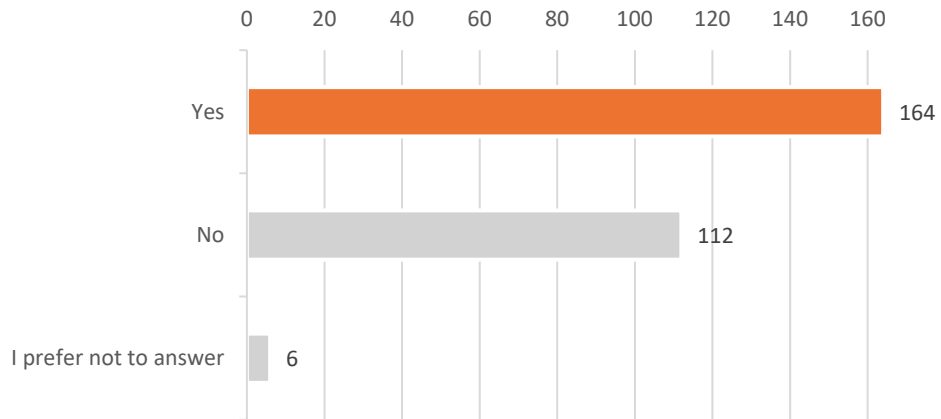

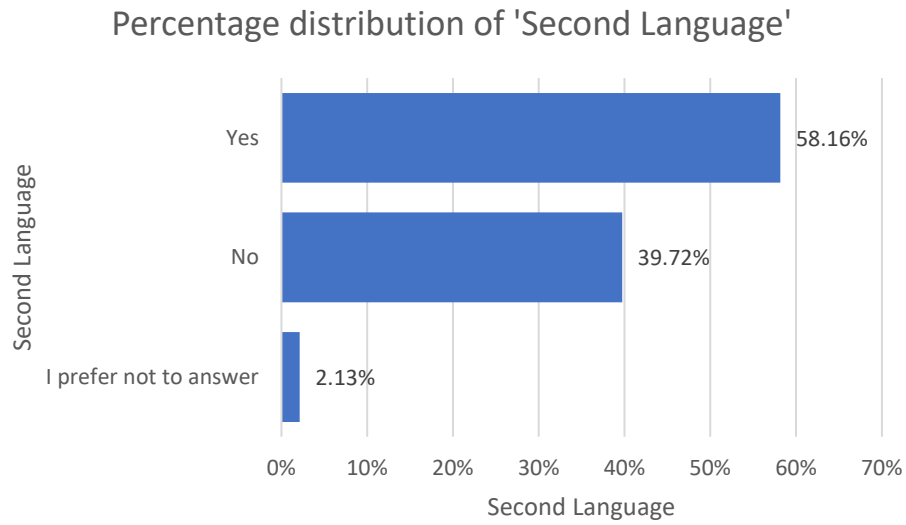

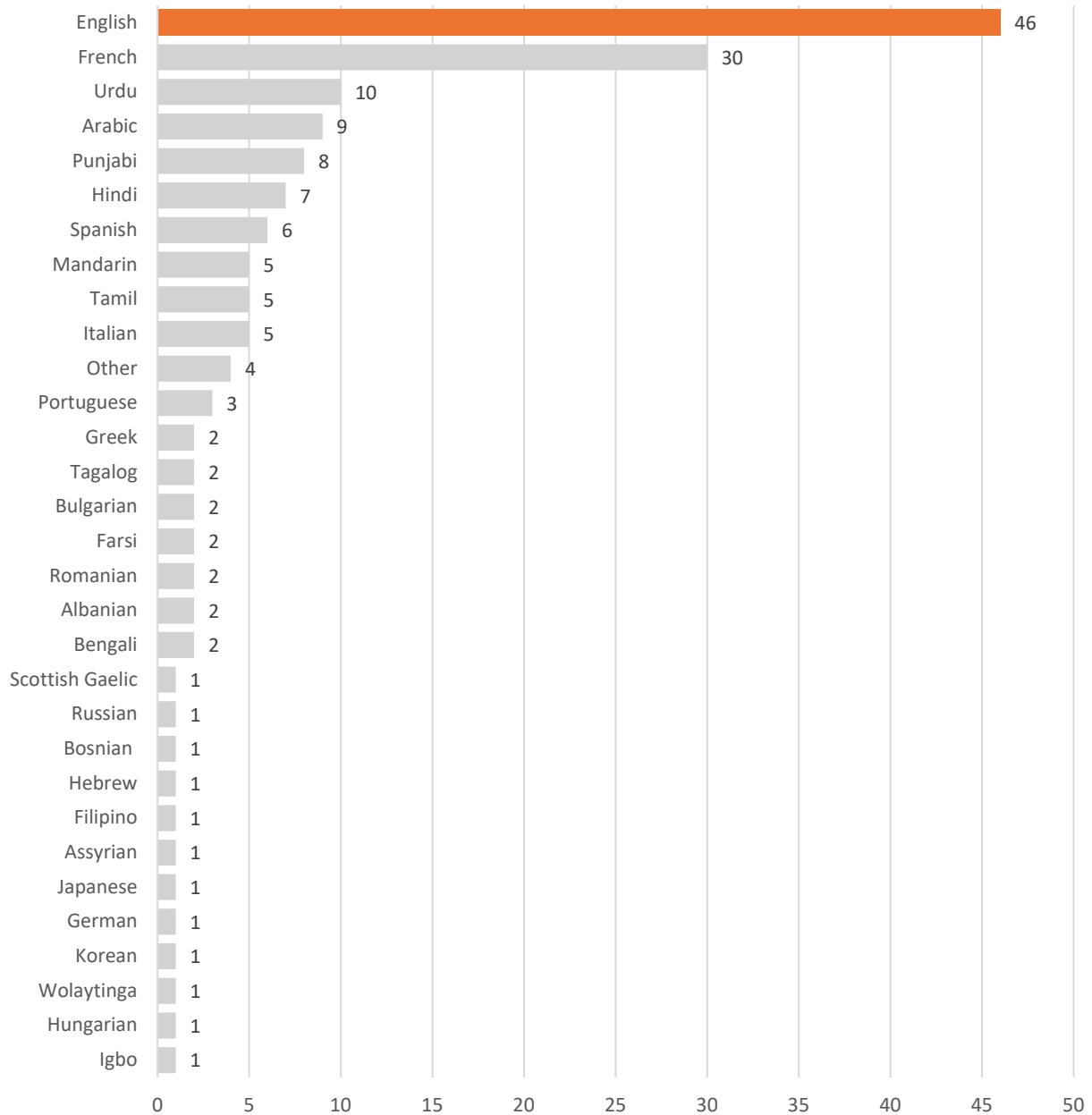

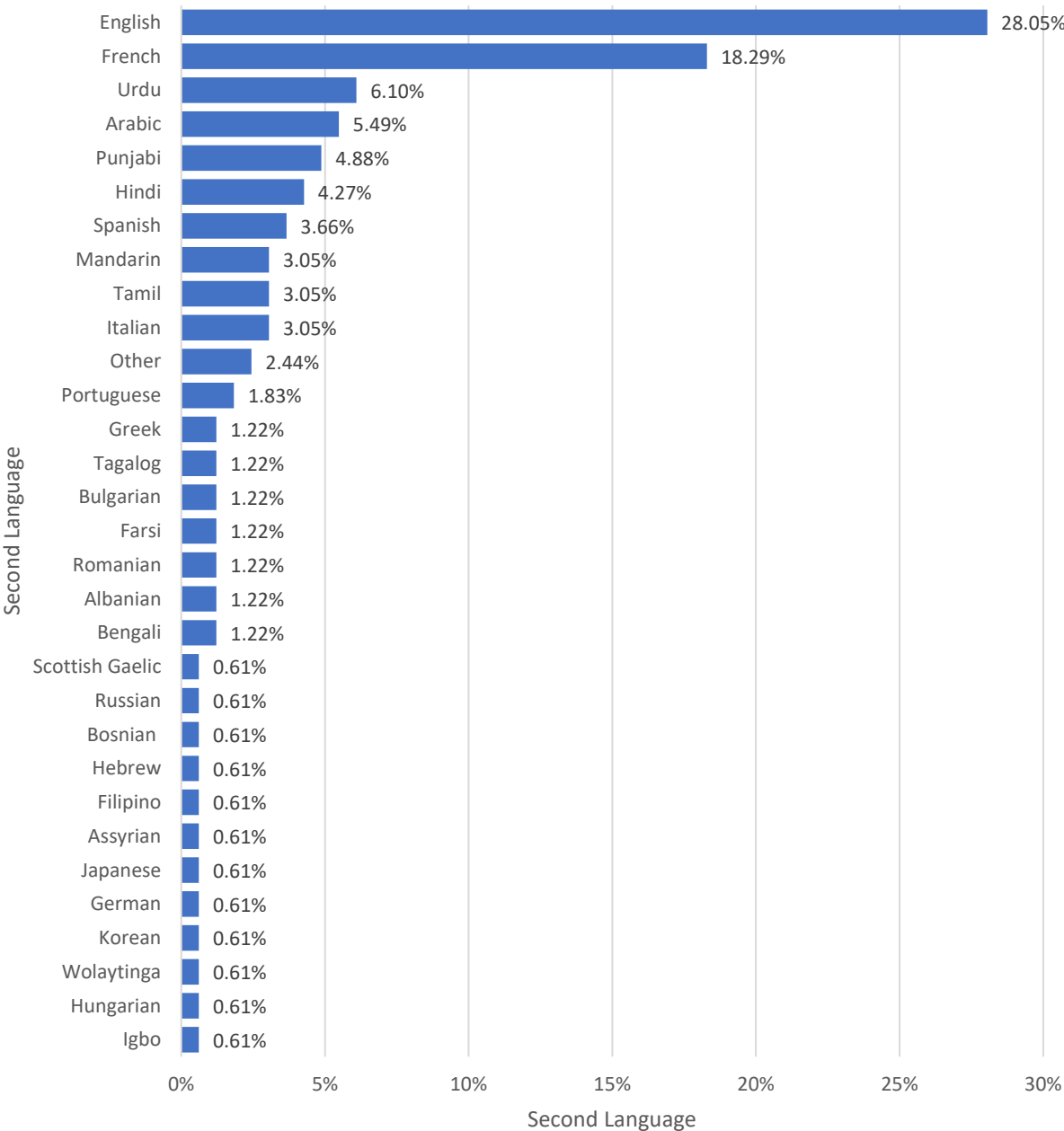

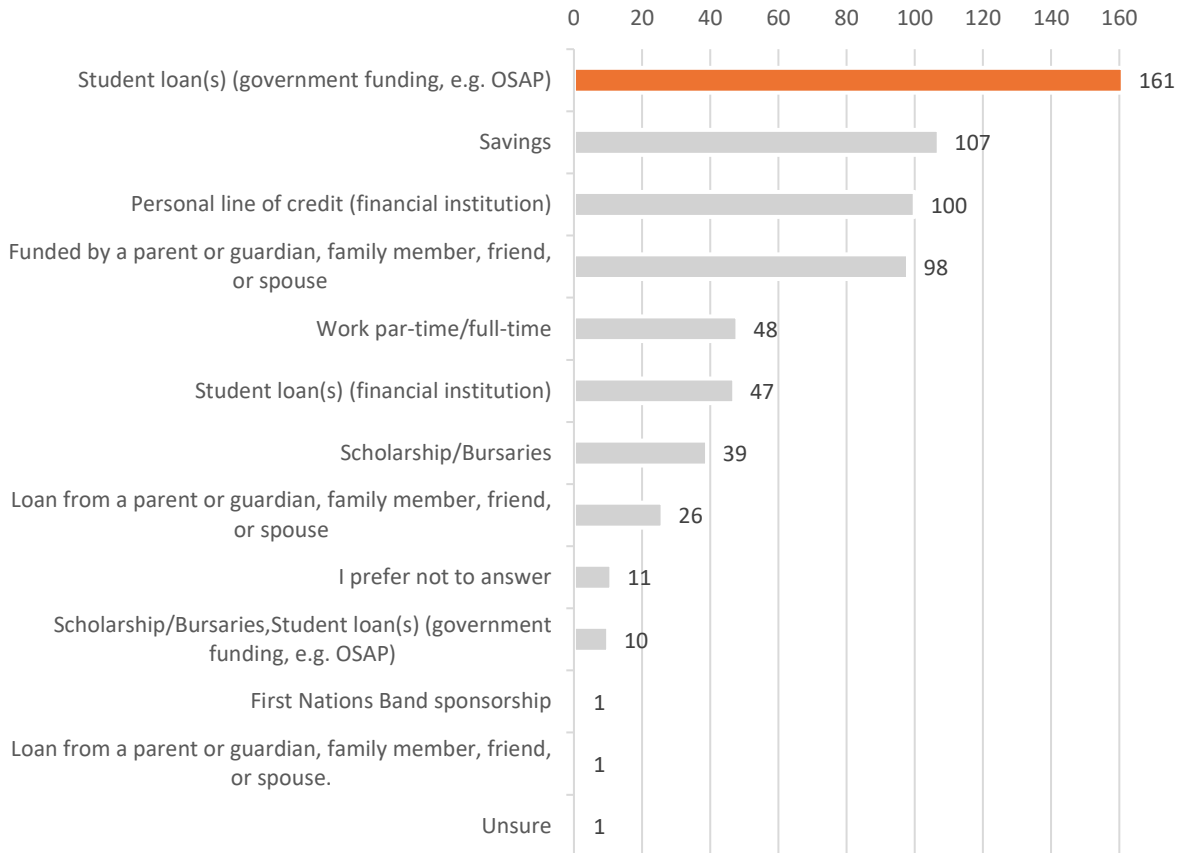

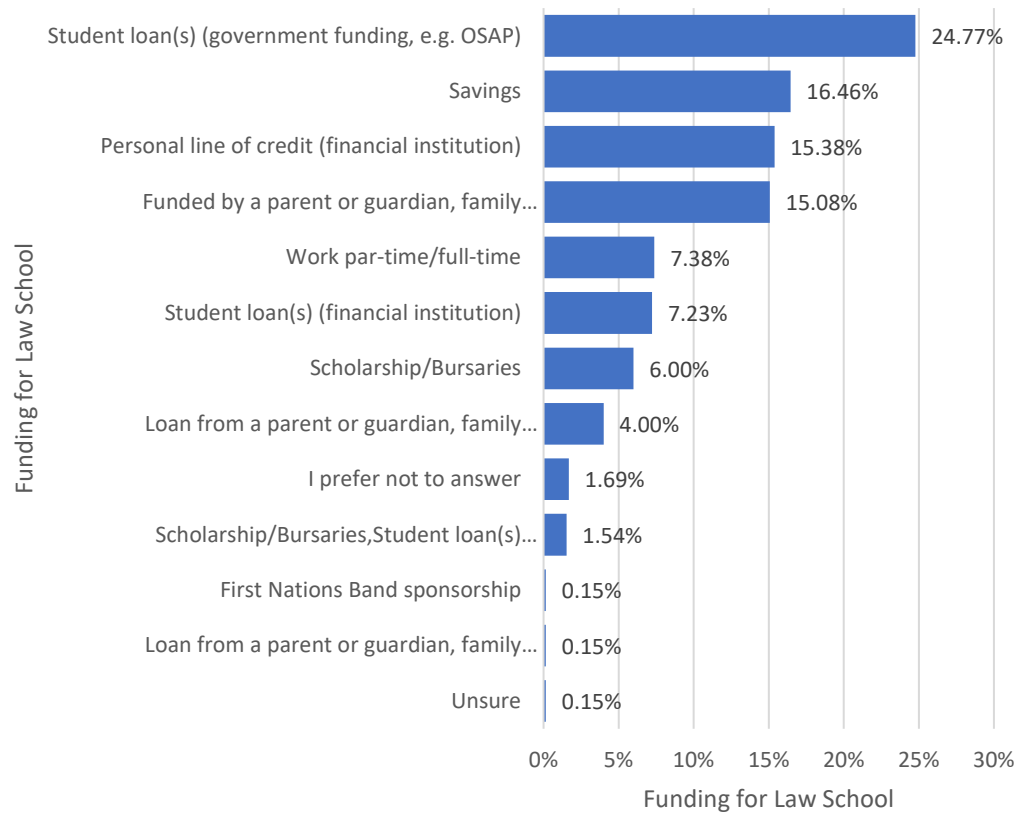

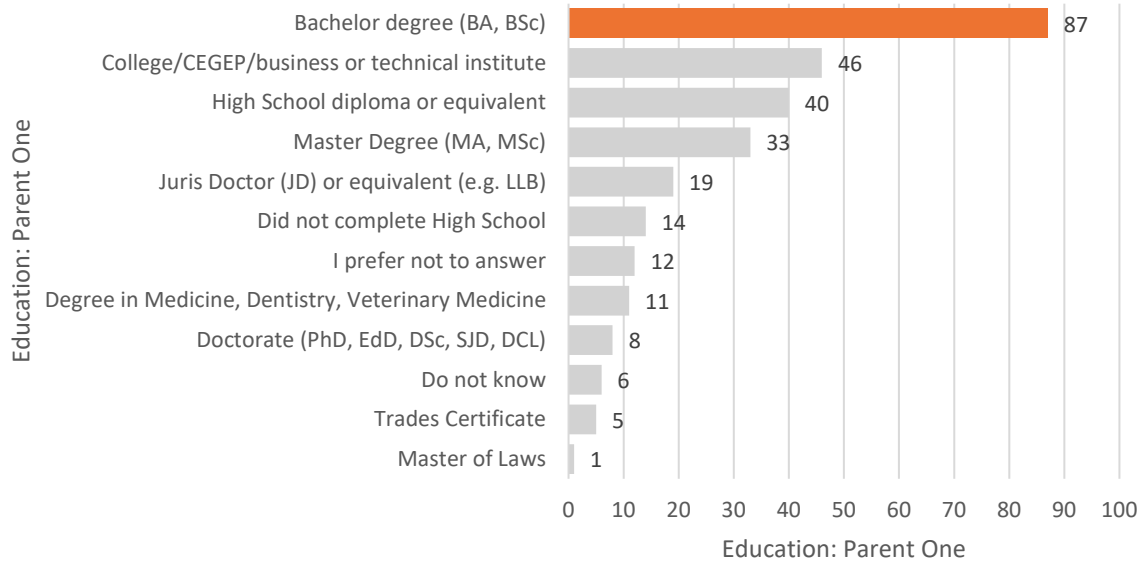

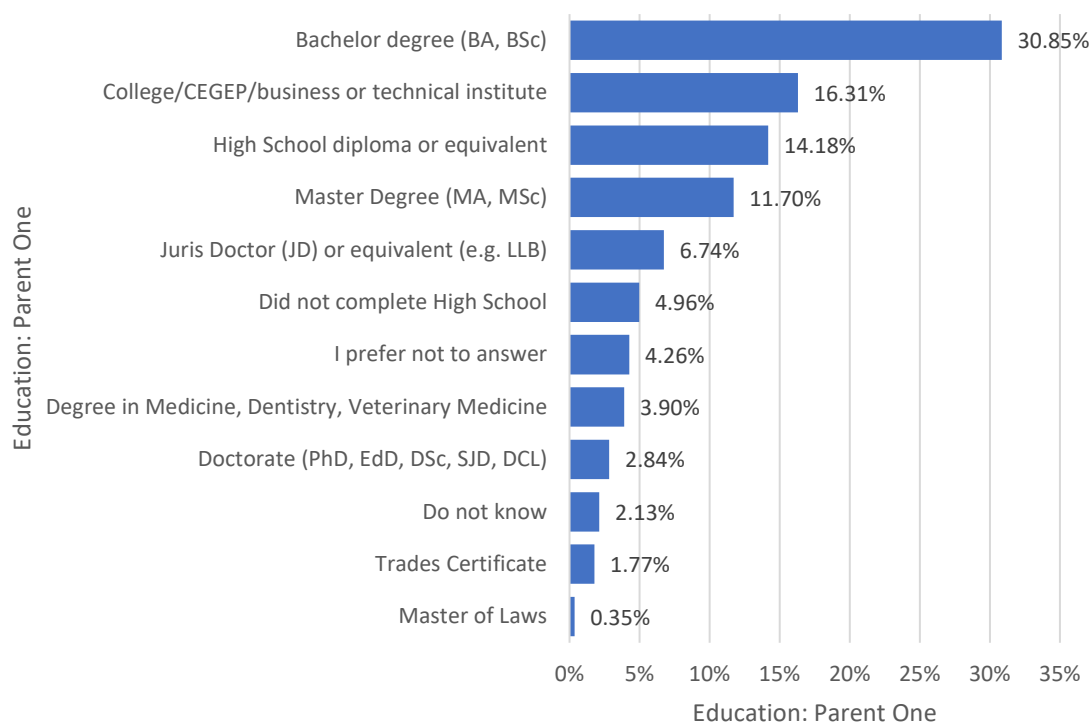

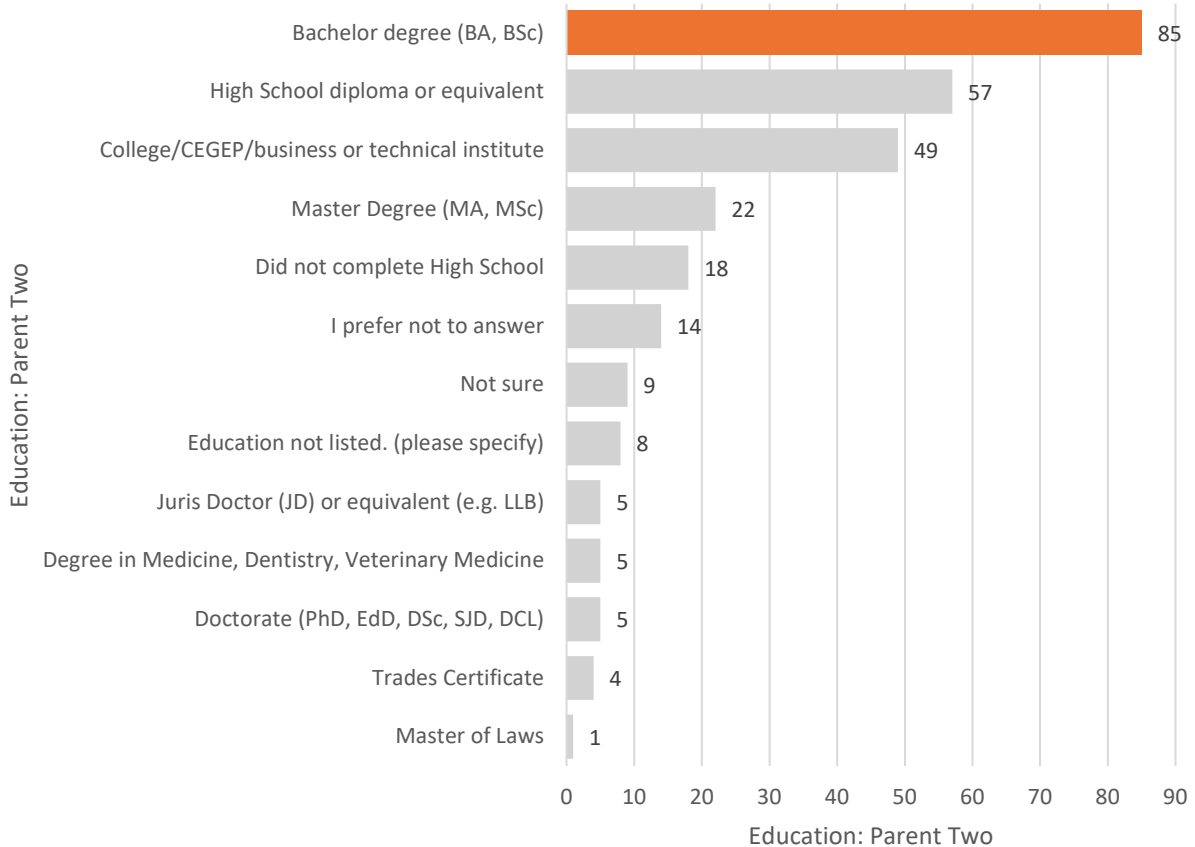

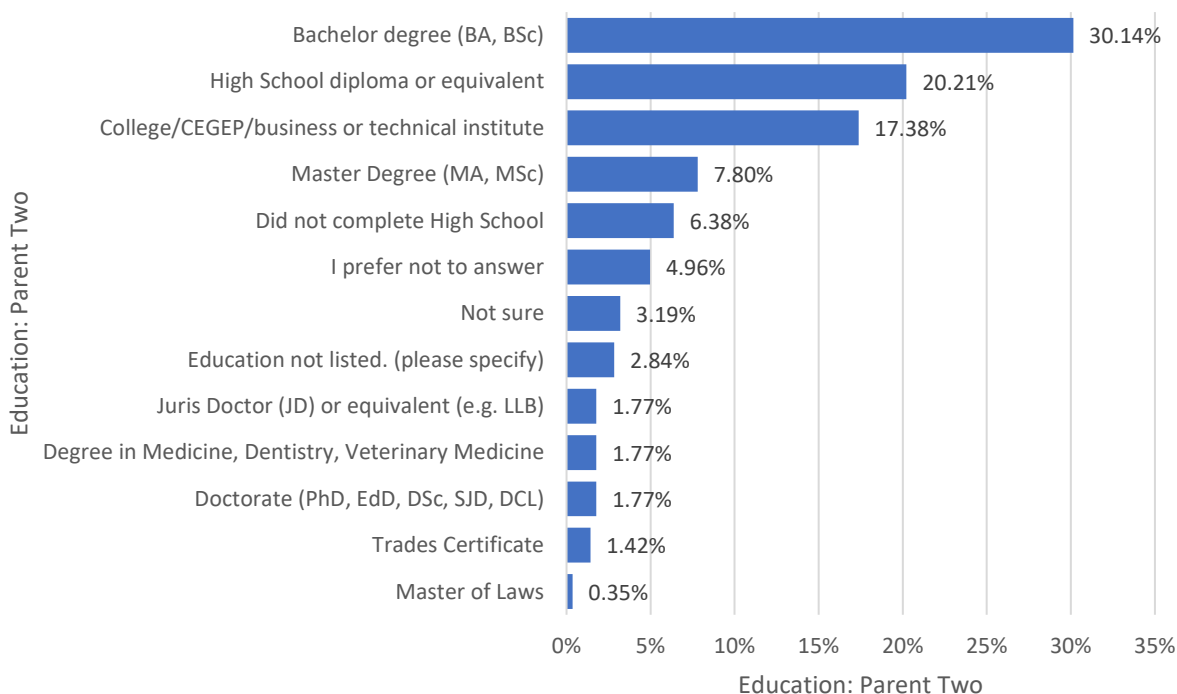

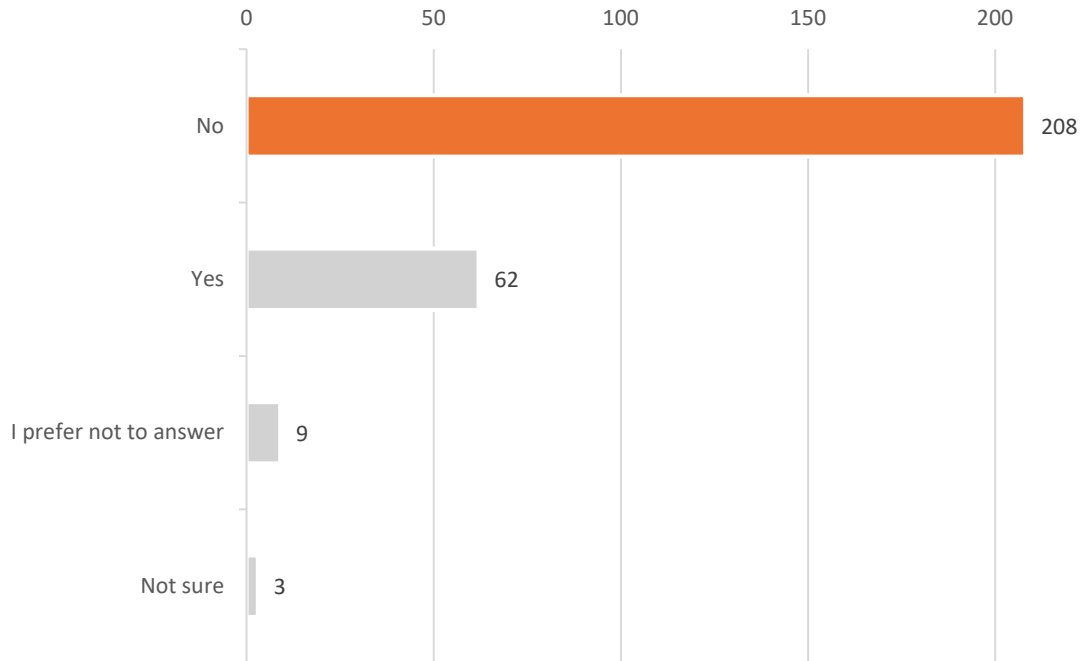

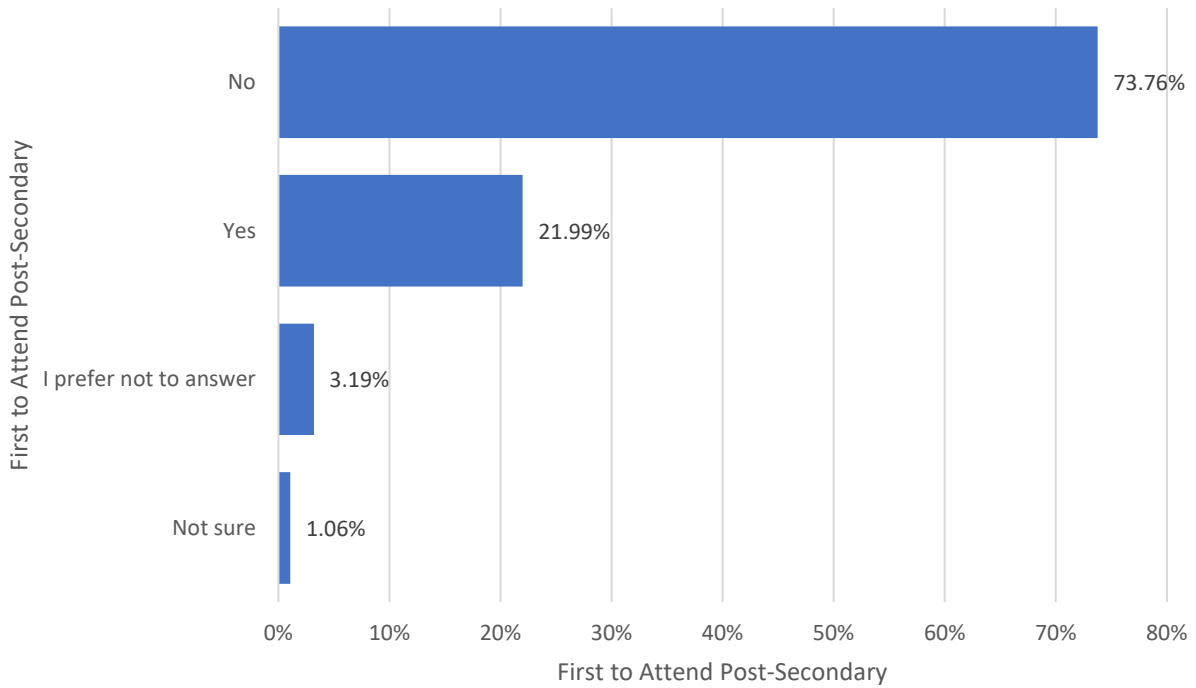

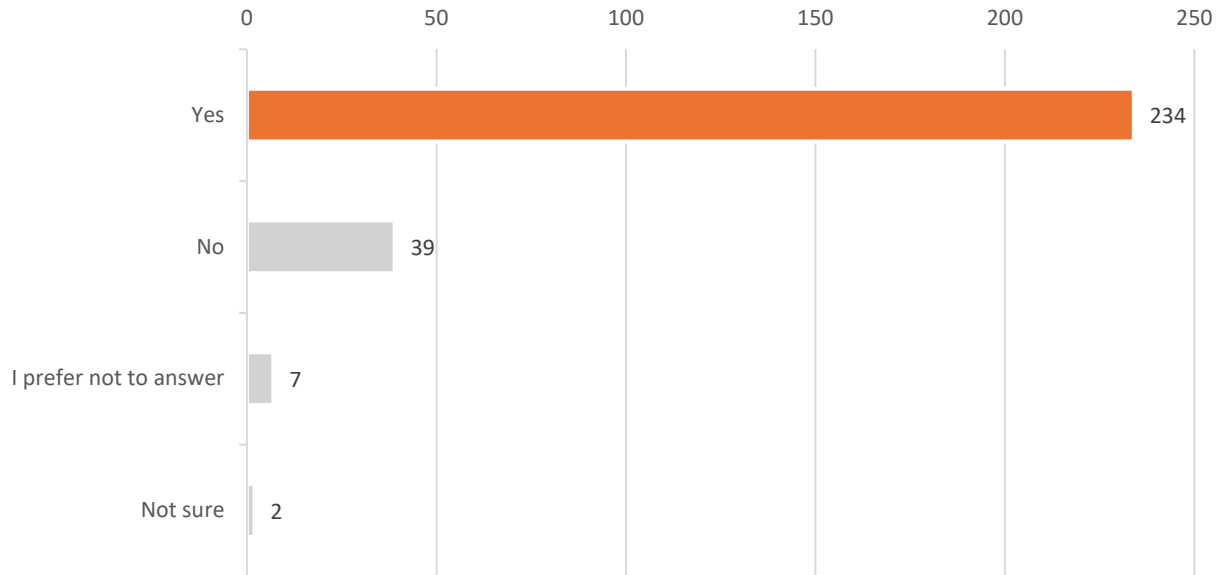

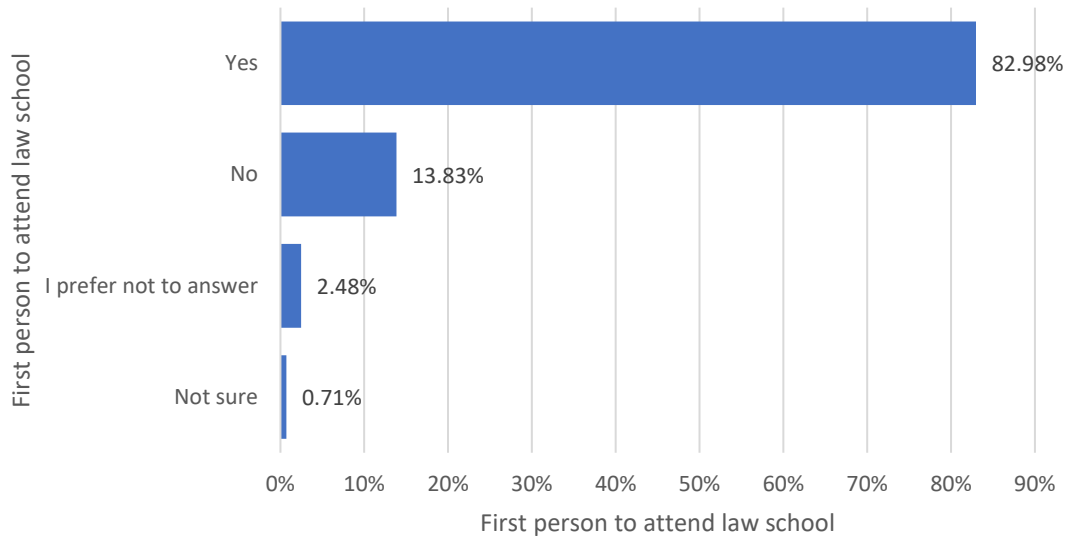

Percentage distribution of 'First person to attend law school'

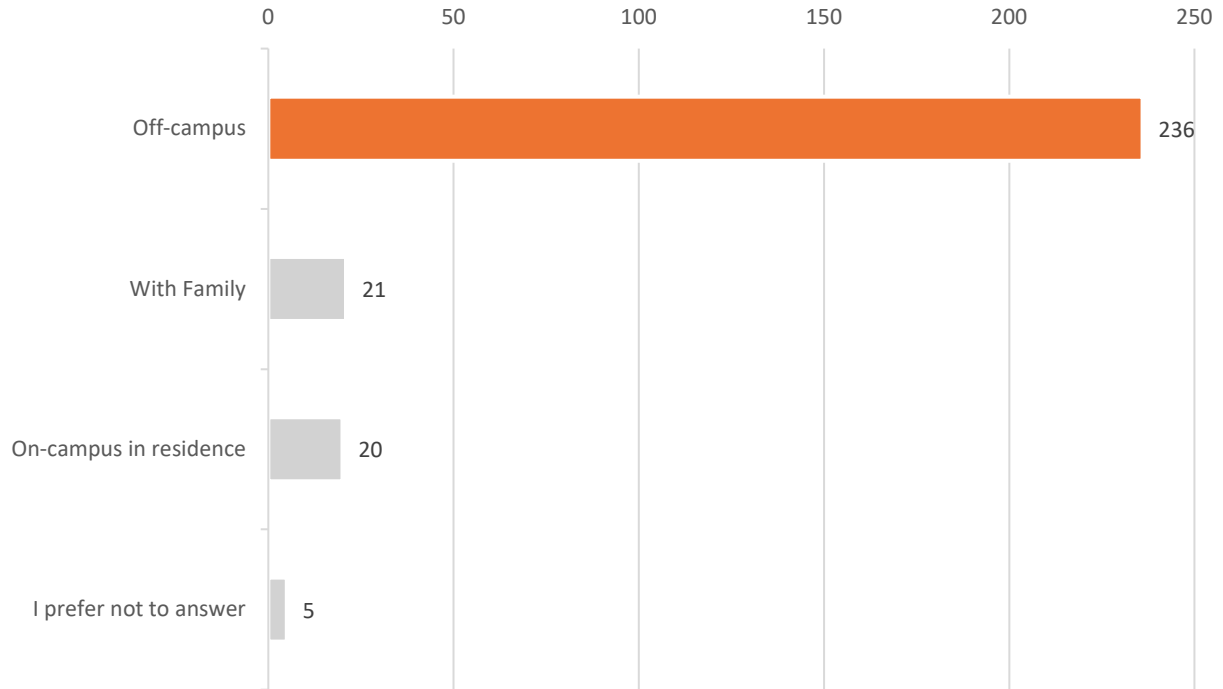

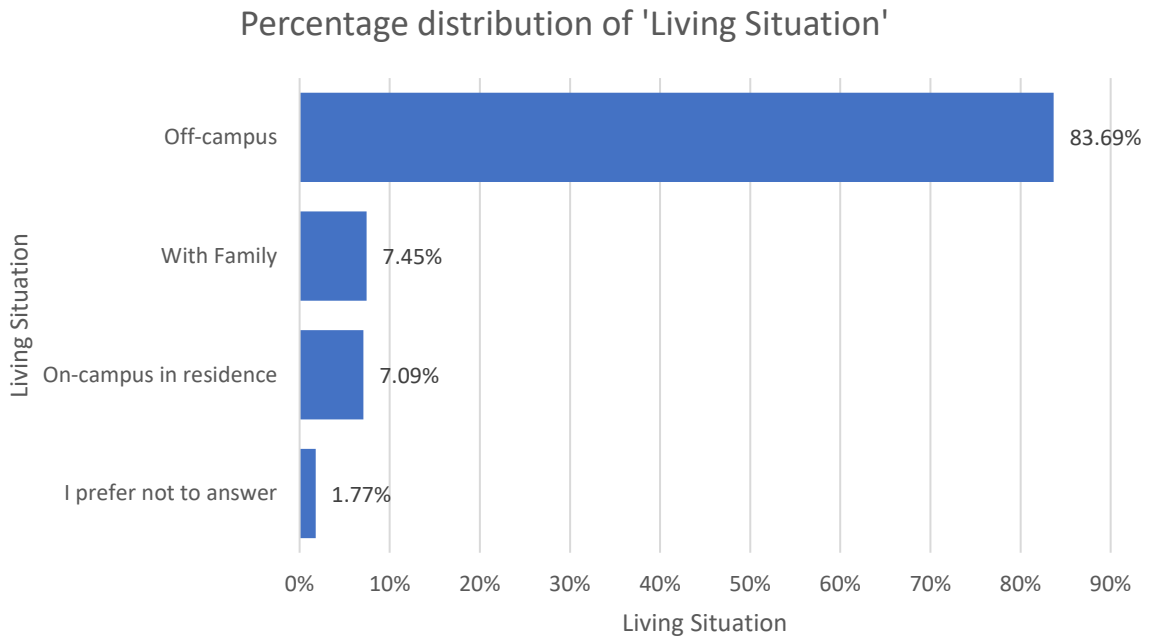

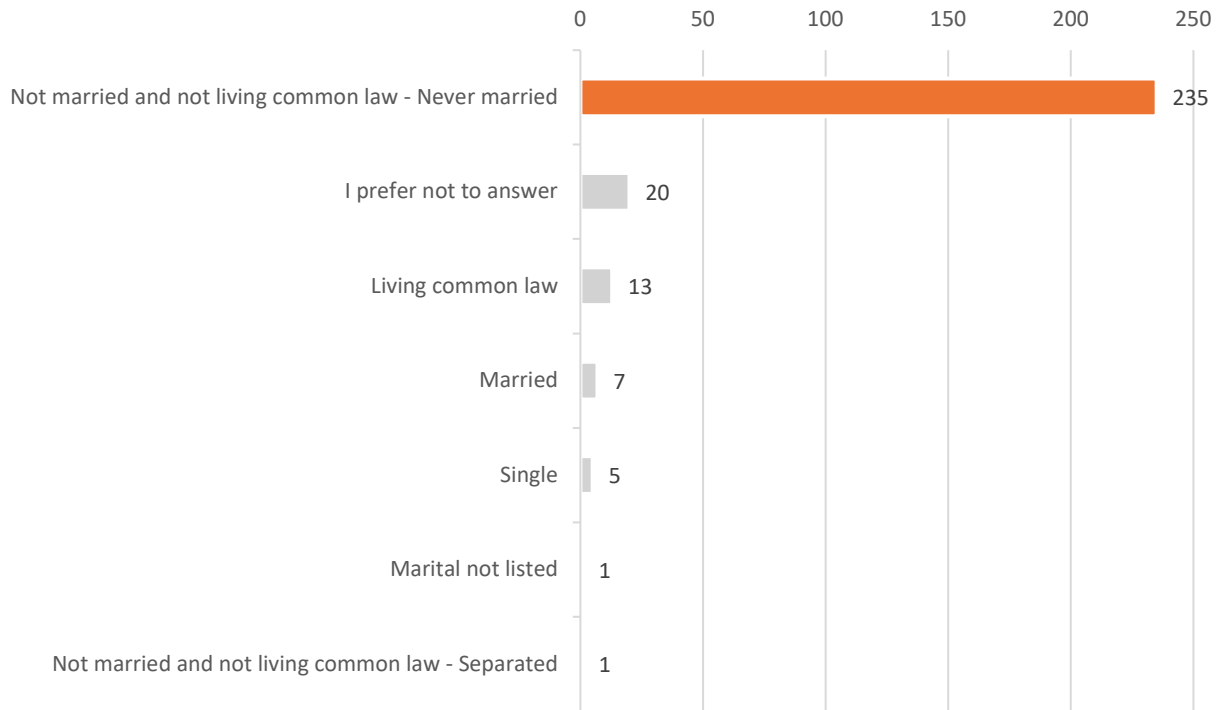

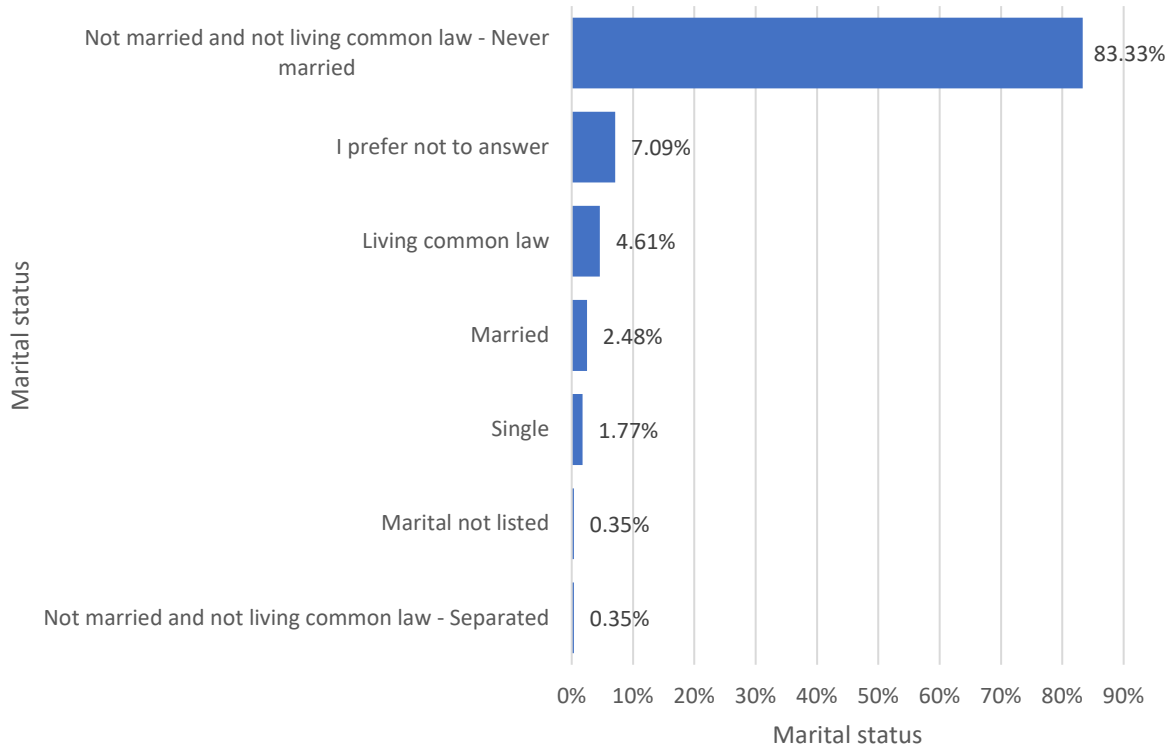

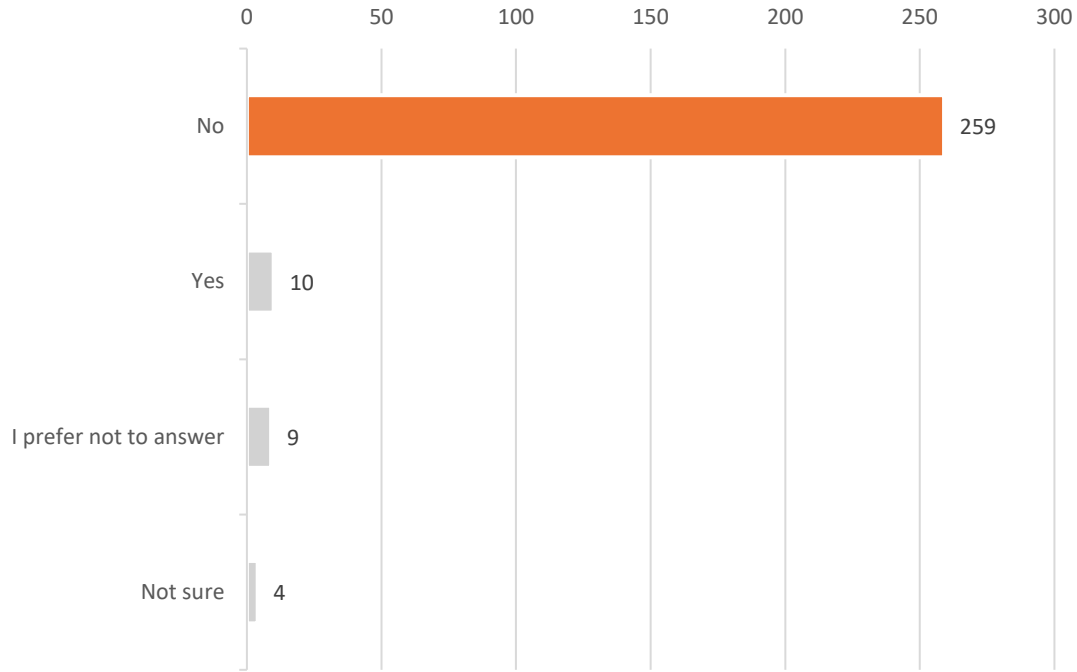

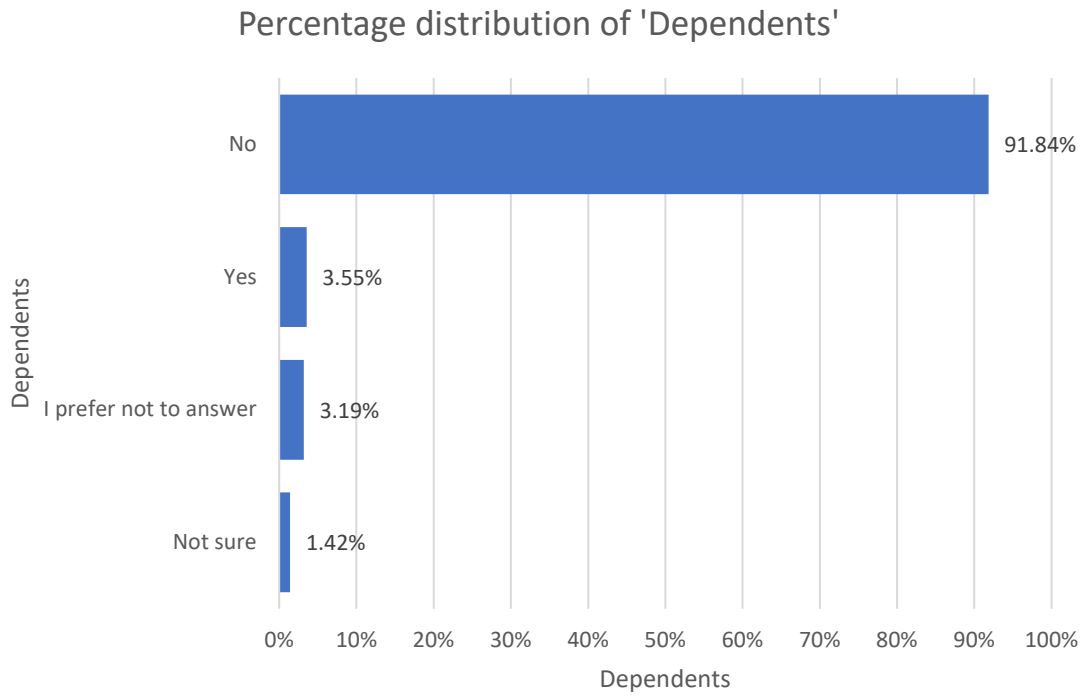
