#### **Expected TA duties:**

Assistants cannot commence their GA/TA duties until email confirmation of the approval of their contract is received from Human Resources (email titled "Authorization to Commence GA/TA Duties").

TA employees are expected to make themselves available to report for all assigned duties, both in-person/on-campus and remote/online duties. "Most classes across the University are held face-to-face on campus, and even online classes may require on-campus face-to-face duties."

#### **Eligibility requirements:**

• Successful applicants must be available to attend at the specified time of the course/lab/exams and to report for all assigned duties, which may include both in-person/on-campus and remote/online duties.

TA appointments shall be offered to qualified applicants in accordance with the criteria specified in <u>Article 12:04</u> of the CUPE 4580 Collective Agreement.

## To be eligible for a Teaching Assistantship you must be a registered undergraduate student:

- Must be registered for the term of work at the time of hiring.
- Must maintain registration throughout the term and must be in good standing in the degree program.
- Must be legally eligible to work in Canada on campus with a valid social insurance number and a valid study permit.

Teaching Assistants can be employed for no more than 100 TA hours per semester total per <u>Article 14</u> of the CUPE 4580 Collective Agreement. If you already hold or have applied for another TA position (in this or another department) note that the **total combined hours** for all TA appointments held in all departments **cannot exceed 100 hours for the Winter term period (January 1-April 30, 2025).** 

## **Required Essential Qualifications:**

- Successful applicants must meet all essential qualifications including the course-specific essential
  qualifications identified in the table above for individual courses. In addition, you must declare any actual or
  potential schedule conflicts with your courses.
- Must be a nursing student at the University of Windsor in graduate or undergraduate studies; must have excellent oral and written communication abilities; and must be highly punctual and dependable.

## **Preferred Qualifications:**

- Preference will be given to applicants who have background in the course area and who have a minimum GPA of 80%.
- Have a demonstrated history of involvement within the Faculty of Nursing (peer mentor, student council) and experience working in long term care in the role of PSW/nurse's aide is an asset
