Bachelor of Education Requirements

All required courses for the BEd program are listed on the registrar website as well. The academic advisor in the Department of Political Science is **only** able to assist students with the BA Political Science (General) side of the program. Students may complete the requirements for the Four-Year Honours BA degree in Political Science as well by completing additional courses during the summer term and/or completing a sixth year. Students wishing to do this should contact the Political Science academic advisor.
