
Introduction

With a faculty-to-student ratio of 1:20, which is the best in Ontario and one of the best in Canada for a comprehensive science program, the Faculty of Science at the University of Windsor is the destination Science program in the Province of Ontario. Faculty members hold international reputations across the scientific disciplines of Biology; Biomedical Sciences; Chemistry and Biochemistry; Computer Science; Economics; Environmental Science and Studies; Forensic Sciences; Mathematics and Statistics; and Physics.

Students have an unprecedented opportunity to participate in undergraduate research, study abroad, and internships, co-ops and externships. This allows students to apply their interests directly to critical issues in the areas of health and biomedical sciences, advanced computing, environment and ecology, and advanced materials.

Programs: The Faculty of Science is home to 30 undergraduate programs in 8 departments and 2 science-wide academic programs as well as numerous graduate programs.



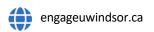



- Graduation Rate (2019/20)^{2,3}: Agriculture & Bio Sci 95.%; Computer Science 67%;
 Mathematics 81%; Physical Sciences 81%
- Graduate Employment Rate, 6 months after graduation (2019/20)^{3,4}: Agriculture & Bio Sci 95.8%; Computer Science 95.6%; Physical Sciences 85.7%
- Graduate Employment Rate, 2 years after graduation (2019/20)^{3,4}: Agriculture & Bio Sci 100%; Computer Science 87.5%; Physical Sciences 100%
- Number of tenured or tenure-track faculty (2019/20): 115
