## DESTINATION SCIENCE

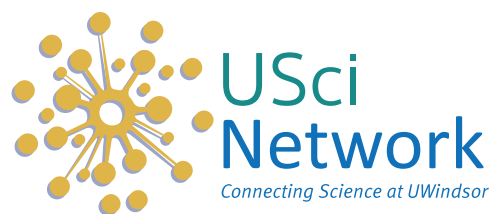
