Executive Team Updates:

- The Executive Team successfully conducted their annual retreat, during which they strategized and refined their plans for the 2024/25 academic year.
- Ongoing discussions with University administration concerning the UWSA's recently passed BDS motion are progressing.
- A formal letter, endorsed by the UWSA Board of Directors, has been drafted and will be submitted to the Senate, Board of Governors, and University Administration by May 27, 2024 urging academic and financial divestment from the Government of Israel, its products and in keeping in line with the University's Responsible Investment Policy.

Vice President of Finance and Operations (VPFO):

- Collaborated closely with UWSA Board Chair Walter Rischke and the UWSA President to organize and facilitate the UWSA Board Orientation.
- Worked in conjunction with the OPUS President, UWSA President, UWSA Vice President of Student Life (VPSL), and General Manager to revise the PMB Constitution and Bylaws.
- Oversaw the coordination of summer bus pass distributions and related advertising efforts.
