4. Outstanding Business/Action Items

4.1 Review Committee on Employment Equity (RCEE) Annual Report

- The Director of the Office of Human Rights, Equity & Accessibility noted that the report included next steps and recommendations towards enhancing equity on campus.
- It was suggested that the recommended sentence "All candidates are expected to articulate the manner in which equity is taken into consideration in their teaching, service, and research" would more appropriately be included as part of the essential criteria listed in positions, rather than at the end of the overall statement on equity at the University.
- The Employment Equity and Human Rights Manager will review data and meet with units across campus to assist in identifying areas of underrepresentation. Other considerations include where visible minorities are within the leadership and the opportunity for leadership roles.

4.2 Report from the Working Group on the University's Equity Structures

- The Provost, Vice-President Academic met with the Dean of Engineering, the 3 Industrial Engineering faculty members, the Department of Mechanical, Automotive and Materials Engineering and both undergraduate and graduate students in Engineering.
- There was some student concern as to how the proposed change might affect their degrees. They were assured that it would not affect their degrees and that their diploma will look the same.
- One of the main issues behind this is change is accreditation. The Canadian Engineering Accreditation Board noted that having 4 faculty members is below critical mass, and that this item had to be addressed by December 2016. The department is now down to 3 members.
