The form will include a section for the referee to provide further comments. The School of Social Work has specific criteria to be addressed on this form as outlined below:

Please provide a statement of your perceptions of the applicant with respect to the following:

- a. Social justice, diversity, and advocacy commitment;
- b. Ability to deal with stressful situations in life;
- c. Personal ethics in dealing with others;
- d. Communication and interpersonal skills;
- e. Potential for leadership in the development of knowledge and practice in social work.

Completion of this reference is a necessary part of the application to graduate studies at The University of Windsor, School of Social Work. Please provide the reference by the application deadline.
