In order to apply for the University of Windsor MSW On Campus program, you must complete the following steps:

Complete the on-line application required by the Faculty of Graduate Studies and Research. This includes the application fee.

Visit the Graduate Studies Website and follow the instruction to pay the fee.

Once you have paid the application fee, you will receive an email with instructions on how to access your application on UWinsite.

Please be advised, there is a turn around time of up to 2 business days between payment being processed and receiving a confirmation email; please keep this in mind when applying to the Program.

The applicant is responsible for collecting *all* required materials and submitting them through UWinsite.

Transcripts:

Transcripts must be submitted for all college, undergraduate and graduate programs you have attended.

Unofficial transcripts can be uploaded into your application; no hard copies will be accepted.

University of Windsor students are required to provide all University of Windsor transcripts.
