### Steps to Financial Support | Important Dates

#### December 1 – April 30

- Apply for entrance scholarships and bursaries by logging into UWinsite Student > Applicant Homepage > Award Profile
  - There is no limit on the number of applications that you can submit.

  - Visit one of our drop-in sessions for one-on-one support
  - Start the process early – don't delay as deadlines cannot be extended beyond April 30.

#### May 1 – June 30

- Submit your application for government student assistance, i.e. OSAP @ [www.ontario.ca/OSAP](http://www.ontario.ca/OSAP) if you would like to be considered for government student loans and grants.
- Students from out of province should check with their home province's financial aid program.
- US students should complete the FAFSA @ [www.studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa](http://www.studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa)
- Register for Enriched Academy using your @uwindsor.ca email address – a financial literacy program for students offered at no cost to UWindsor students.
  - Through a series of fun, insightful videos, Enriched Academy will help you:
    - ✓ steer away from poor money management traps
    - ✓ avoid credit card traps that can bury you in debt
    - ✓ understand the fundamentals of saving and investing early

  - First deadline for need-based bursaries – October 15
  - Start the process early so you don't miss out – don't delay – there are varying deadlines.
