Student Awards & Financial Aid Steps to Financial Support | Important Dates

December 1 - April 30

- Apply for entrance scholarships and bursaries by logging into UWinsite Student
 Applicant Homepage > Award Profile
 - o There is no limit on the number of applications that you can submit.

 - o Visit one of our drop-in sessions for one-on-one support
 - Start the process early don't delay as deadlines cannot be extended beyond April 30.

May 1 – June 30

- Submit your application for government student assistance, i.e. OSAP @ www.ontario.ca/OSAP if you would like to be considered for government student loans and grants.
- Students from out of province should check with their home province's financial aid program.
- US students should complete the FAFSA @ www.studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa
- Register for Enriched Academy using your @uwindsor.ca email address a financial literacy program for students offered at no cost to UWindsor students.

August 1 – August 15

 - o First deadline for need-based bursaries October 15
 - Start the process early so you don't miss out don't delay there are varying deadlines.
